PREAMBLE: Prophetic

Hence to endorse this great month, the good Lord has given me a prophetic word of grace for this month. It's taken from **Isaiah 40:28-31** "Have you not known? Have you not heard? The everlasting God, the Lord, the Creator of the ends of the earth, does not faint or grow weary; there is no searching of His understanding. 29 **He gives power** to the faint and weary, and to him who has no might He increases strength [causing it to multiply and making it to abound]. 30 Even youths shall faint and be weary, and [selected] young men shall feebly stumble and fall exhausted; 31 But those who wait for the Lord [who expect, look for, and hope in Him] shall change and renew their strength and power; they shall lift their wings and mount up

[close to God] as eagles [mount up to the sun]; they shall run and not be weary, they shall walk and not faint or become tired." (Amplified)

I pray that you will enjoy His graciousness in this scripture of **Isaiah 40:28-31** above, this is because; there is a river in Zion, the city of God and the church of the almighty God. That as you walk in it through this month, it shall become the beginning of unending rain of God's abundant promised blessings wherein you cannot be moved again by the noise of the enemy and cohorts - **Psalms 46; Hebrews 12:22-24.** You will then soar as an eagle over all limitations, walk on your high heels over your high places, into your place of divine deliverance, holiness and possessing of possessions in Christ Jesus our Lord and Saviour -King, Amen! - **Obadiah 17; Habakkuk 3:18-19).**

was ten thousand times ten thousand, and thousands of thousands; 12 saying with a loud voice, Worthy is the Lamb that was slain to receive power, and riches, and wisdom, and strength, and honour, and glory, and blessing."

Ephesians 4:7-8 "But unto every one of us is given grace according to the measure of the gift of Christ. 8 Wherefore he saith, When he ascended up on high, he led captivity captive, and gave gifts unto men."

Psalms 68:18 "Thou hast ascended on high, thou hast led captivity captive: thou hast **received gifts for men**; yea, for **the rebellious also, that the Lord God might dwell among them**."

Ephesians 1:3-6 "Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who hath blessed us with all spiritual blessings in heavenly places in Christ: 4 according as he hath chosen us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before him in love: 5 having predestinated us unto the adoption of children by Jesus Christ to himself, according to the good pleasure of his will, 6 to the praise of the glory of his grace, wherein he hath made us accepted in the beloved."

2 Peter 1:1-5 "Simon Peter, a servant and an apostle of Jesus Christ, to them that have obtained like precious faith with us through the righteousness of God and our Saviour Jesus Christ: 2 Grace and peace be multiplied unto you through the knowledge of God, and of Jesus our Lord, 3 according as his divine power hath given unto us all things that pertain unto life and godliness, through the knowledge of him that hath called us to glory and virtue: 4 whereby are given unto us exceeding great and precious promises: that by these ye might be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust."

There is a place of gracious strength in the kingdom. There are promised blessings in the kingdom. When the Lord redeemed us from the power of darkness, we were enshrined into the kingdom of His grace in our Lord Jesus - Colossians 1:13-14. Galatians 3:13-14, indicates that when our Lord Jesus took our place, He took our curse and gave us the Father's blessings. The blessing enshrined in the faith of faithful Abraham for all families in all human race - Genesis 12:1-5. Ephe**sians 1:3-6** says that we had being blessed with all spiritual blessings in the heavenly places. Meaning, all you need to live by is already settled and available, all you need to do is to appropriate it into your being in order to do life effectually and effectively. Doing life effectually is living efficiently, it is to do things well; while doing life effectively is to do the right things well and produce results, that is, to bring forth fruit in due season according to the working of God. Hence the Ephesians scriptural verses indicate that God had blessed us, chosen us and made us acceptable in the beloved.

2 Peter 1:1-5 gives another side of God's promised blessings. It tells us that by the virtue of us having obtained the precious faith in the Lord, that is, being born of God we have His nature; and by His divine nature He has given us access to all things that pertain to our earthly life and living a heavenly godly life. More so, He has given us exceedingly great and precious promises that enable us to overcome the corruption that is in the world.

Ephesians 4:7-8 and Psalms 68:18 also tells us that when Jesus ascended and enthroned, He gave gifts, that is spiritual blessings to men. He gave us spiritual fruit - Galatians 5:22-23, spiritual gifts - 2 Corinthians 12:4-11, 28-31 and ministerial gifts - Ephesians **4:11-6.** The spiritual gifts are to enhance the ministerial gifts – offices - in the body ministry and all that pertains to doing life in God's plan, purpose and pursuit. The spiritual fruit of the spiritual gifts is to produce the Christian faith character that we have of our God. I can perceive of God that as many who diligently covet after these spiritual provisions of God will definitely have them to enhance them in all aspects of life and godliness. This is the month for a complete, whole and perfect time for you to ask God to endow you with spiritual gifting's to enhance the walk of life in your hand and the spiritual fruit to enhance a befitting Christ-like character in every area of your life. You cannot afford to do without them if you must make the mark of being strong in the Lord and in the power of His might a reality.

Revelation 5:9-12, indicates that the redeemed of the Lord had being blessed to reign in life with a new song. For they sang a new song - a song of victory, triumph, mercy, redemption and more; but not a song of defeat, failure, complaint and such like which was sung before they were redeemed. It would be a great blessing to see you speak forth songs of victory, triumph and more and not songs of defeat and failure.

Much more, the redeemed had being blessed with seven redemption covenants of grace - **Revelation 5:12**. Which when actualised will make one's life great. You need to be strong in the Lord and in the power of His might in order to actualise them in your daily life in the face of opposing enemy and cohorts. The seven redemptive covenant deeds and blessings received on our behalf are summed up in these:

- **Power & Authority** In place of oppression, fear, intimidation etc. Luke 10:19; 2 Timothy 1:7.
- **Riches (Prosperity)** In place of poverty, hunger, thirst etc. 2 Corinthians 8:9; Philippians 4:19.

To be strong is a dynamic doing in spiritual exercise as the scriptures will like us do: Be strong in the Lord - Ephesians 6:10; be strong in the grace - 2 Timothy 2:1; grow in strength in the spirit - Luke 1:80; let the weak say I am strong - Joel **3:10** and more.

- **Wisdom (Mental IQ)** In place of ignorance, foolishness, etc. James 1:5, Luke 2:40, 52.
- **Strength (Physique)** In place of weakness, sickness and all 'ness etc. Philippians 4:13; Isaiah 40:28-31.
- **Honour (Dignity)** In place of dishonour, disdain, inferiority complex, intimidation and timidity, etc. Colossians 1:13-14; Ephesians 1:7; 2 Timothy 1:7.
- **Glory (Beauty)** In place of shame, reproach. Isaiah 61:3; 1 Peter 2:5, 9.
- Blessings (Grace) In place of curses, setbacks, stagnation etc.
 Ephesians 1:3; 2 Pet. 1:3-4; John 10:10.

I can conclude by **John 10:10** "The thief comes only in order to **steal** and **kill** and **destroy**. I came that they may have and enjoy life, and have it in abundance (to the full, till it overflows)" (Amplified), meaning that there are a lot of promised blessings for you as a child of God to enjoy and have in overflow. It is the very act of being strong in the Lord through which these spiritual blessings can be actualised and appropriated into reality.

The Joy of The Lord:

Nehemiah 8:9-11 "9 And Nehemiah, who was the governor, Ezra the priest and scribe, and the Levites who taught the people said to all the people, "This day is holy to the Lord your God; do not mourn nor weep." For all the people wept, when they heard the words of the Law. 10 Then he said to them, "Go your way, eat the fat, drink the sweet, and send portions to those for whom nothing is prepared; for this day is holy to our Lord. Do not sorrow, for the joy of the Lord is your strength. 11 So the Levites quieted all the people, saying, "Be still, for the day is holy; do not be grieved." (NKJV).

Psalms 84:5-7 "Blessed is the man whose strength is in thee; in whose heart are the ways of them. 6 Who passing through the valley of Baca make it a well; the rain also filleth the pools. 7 They go from strength to strength, every one of them in Zion appeareth before God."

Job 17:9 "The righteous also shall hold on his way, and he that hath clean hands shall be stronger and stronger."


I appreciate the kind of church in Nehemiah, Ezra and that of the teaching Levites. A church where God's presence is not a place of mourning, weeping or a place of sorrow and grieve, but a place of rejoicing, a place people eat, drink and give to others in need. Simply put, where the joy of the Lord is our strength - **Psalms 16:11**. That's exactly the picture that **Nehemiah 8:9-11** wanted you to have of God. Meaning your strength is God's joy not your weakness. God wants you to be strong because He takes delight in your being strong.

Psalms 84:5-7 helps to let you and I know that when your source of strength is of the Lord, you are definitely going to be blessed. Because everyone who appears in God's presence individually or in His Church called Zion, shall go from strength to strength. God rejoices in seeing you strong, triumphing from strength to strength every day of your life and in every place - 2 Corinthians 2:14. It is for this we are told in **Isaiah 40:28-31**, that the God we serve, is the God of creation, He neither faints nor grows weary; rather He gives power and strength to those who faint and are weary of life. He wants to give them the eagle wings to mount on over their challenges. God wants you to be strong and not faint or give up for anything He had promised you a blessing for, hence in **Luke 18:1**, He calls us to seek strength from Him in prayer rather than giving up or in to the enemy and cohorts.

Job 17:9 concludes, that those who have a clean hands, washed and justified by faith and by the blood of the lamb and are made holy by the deeds of Christ Jesus our Saviour and Lord, shall be stronger and stronger in the Lord. Therefore, take instruction from **Nehemiah 8:9-11**, not to be grieved with life or faint and be weary, mourning and weeping, but go to God's holy place and receive the strength to do life and live godly.

Being Strong In The Lord:

Ephesians 6:10-13 "In conclusion, be strong in the Lord [be empowered through your union with Him]; draw your strength from Him [that strength which His boundless might provides]. 11 Put on God's whole armor [the armor of a heavy-armed soldier which God supplies], that you may be able successfully to stand up against [all] the strategies and the deceits of the devil. 12 For we are not wrestling with flesh and blood [contending only with physical opponents], but against the despotisms, against the powers, against [the master spirits who



are] the world rulers of this present darkness, against the spirit forces of wickedness in the heavenly (supernatural) sphere. 13 Therefore put on God's complete armor, that you may be able to resist and stand your ground on the evil day [of danger], and, having done all [the crisis demands], to stand [firmly in your place]." (Amplified)

Philippians 4:13 ""I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me.

Being strong in the Lord is not just advice, but a scriptural requirement to be obeyed with strong adherence if we must triumph in this present life with testimony. It means that one should let his strength be in the Lord, come from the Lord and be within the Lord's sphere. It means being empowered through your union with Him; draw your strength from Him, that strength which His boundless might provide. That is, ensuring the Lord to be your solid rock of strength and stronghold. This is what **Ephesians 6:10** speaks about.

I can testify strongly that except achievers in Christ are engrossed with this shield of grace 'being strong in the Lord' such will never be able to fulfill in life nor make a remarkable event that will have eternal effect - Colossians 4:17. Since the age 11 when I gave my life to Christ, that is, being born of God, I have seen and fought many divers kinds of life battles - be it spiritual, marital, family, financial, academic, physical (health), parenting, ministry and more; In all, God being my stronghold and sufficiency of strength, He has always given me high heel stands over the challenging high places - Habakkuk 3:17-19. Because where challenges abound grace abounds much more from the Lord to triumph, win and be victorious; and to make all things abound and work for your good - Romans 8:28; Philippians 1:6.

The Greek word for being 'STRONG' is 'endunamo' and is translated to possess strength or to be strengthened. This can be found in many scriptures in the bible. To be strong is a dynamic doing in spiritual exercise as the scriptures will like us do: Be strong in the Lord - **Ephesians 6:10**; be strong in the grace - **2 Timothy 2:1**; grow in strength in the spirit - **Luke 1:80**; let the weak say I am strong - **Joel 3:10** and more.

The adage, 'heaven helps those who help themselves' has no scriptural basis. When the scripture says in **Ephesians 6:10**, we should be strong in the Lord and in the power of His might, it is a kingdom business deed and requirements that make triumph and victory possible. For by the deeds of the flesh 'heaven help those who help themselves' by any means will not make any man prevail in life with God - **1 Samuel 2:9**. It is this knowing that makes Apostle Paul to say in **Philippians 4:13** that he can do all things from the strength that he receives because of what Jesus has done. He knew that by his academic strength as a well-read man - **Acts 22:3**, he was helpless and powerless in doing life and

living godly without being strong in the Lord.

Why Be Strong In The Lord:

Ephesians 6:11-13 " Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. 12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places. 13 Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand."

- **1 Peter 5:8** "Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour"
- **2 Peter 1:1-4** "Grace and peace be multiplied unto you through the knowledge of God, and of Jesus our Lord, 3 according as his divine power hath given unto us all things that pertain unto life and godliness, through the knowledge of him that hath called us to glory and virtue: 4 whereby are given unto us exceeding great and precious promises: that by these ye might be partakers of the divine nature, **having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust.**"

2 Corinthians 10:3-6 "For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war after the flesh: 4 (for the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds;) 5 casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ; 6 and having in a readiness to revenge all disobedience, when your obedience is fulfilled." **r.**"

The saying goes that if you don't give the devil and his cohort's attention or permission, they will not give you any sense of direction.

Hence Apostle Paul in his writing of **Ephesians 6:10-13 and 2 Corinthians 10:3-6** indicates the reason why we should be strong in the Lord and in the power of His might. It's simply because we are en-

gaged in spiritual warfare. For life in essence is not just what we see or sense with our five senses. There is a battle of the enemy and cohorts against us and about us not being able to actualise the fullness of God's promised blessings in our lives as discussed earlier. When you think and remember Daniel's prayer experience in **Daniel 10** with the prince of Persia hindering his promised blessings; then you can appreciate what it means to be strong in the Lord or you will give up, go weary and faint, mourn, cry and grieve.

It is for these acts of the enemy and cohorts that Apostle Peter writing in **1 Peter 5:8** tells us to be alert, vigilant because our enemy and cohorts are going about looking for any loop holes in our life to come over and build a tent; in effect, we will be enslaved by his camouflaged lionlike roar. It is when we are strong in the Lord that we preserve and enjoy our promised blessings and overcome the corruption that is in operation in the world through lustful desires as in **2 Peter 1:1-4**. You can only appreciate it when you recall the lustful desires that Satan using the serpent as cohorts presented to Adam and Eve in **Genesis 3** and to our Lord Jesus Christ in **Luke 4:1-13** and **Matthew 4:1-11**; of which we were warned of this justfulness in the world in **1 John 2:15-17**.

2 Corinthians 10:3-6 and **Galatians 5:16-17, 24-25** indicate how our human member called the flesh is at war with the will of God concerning us by the Holy Spirit that indwells in us. It is only when we are strong in the Lord and the power of His might that we can submit and bring this human flesh under control that we might be able to live, fulfilling that which will lead us into God's promised blessings.

There is the evil in the World and it operates most times in and through the human flesh. It is true that Jesus paid the price for our redemption to give us the victory as in **Galatians 1:3-5**, but we need to be strong in the Lord if we must triumph and win in life over the threat of this enemy and cohorts against our Faith in the Lord. For when we are weak, we easily give the enemy the attention he craves for to give us another direction as he has done to many who fell off their faith in the Lord before us.

Other Sources of Strength:

Jeremiah 9:23-24 "Thus saith the Lord, Let not the wise man glory in his wisdom, neither let the mighty man glory in his might, let not the rich man glory in his riches: 24 but let him that glorieth glory in this, that he understandeth and knoweth me, that I am the Lord which exercise lovingkindness, judgment, and righteousness, in the earth: for in these things I delight, saith the Lord."

Psalms 49:6-13 "They that trust in their wealth, and boast themselves in the multitude of their riches; 7 none of them can by any means redeem his brother, nor give to God a ransom for him: 8 (for the redemption of their soul is precious, and it ceaseth for ever:)

9 that he should still live for ever, and not see corruption. 10 For he seeth that wise men die, likewise the fool and the brutish person perish, and leave their wealth to others. 11 Their inward thought is, that their houses shall continue for ever, and their dwelling places to all generations; they call their lands after their own names. 12 Nevertheless man being in honour abideth not: he is like the beasts that perish. 13 This their way is their folly: yet their posterity approve their sayings."

Make no mistake, there are other sources of strength which I will just highlight to have you do a check balance and stocktaking of your faith as an achiever with God. Many times the enemy has created a make believe world in the Church which we buy into, not knowing that we have given the enemy and cohorts attention wherein they use that opportunity to ruin our life and destiny with God.

"I remember going into a home to evangelise when I was a teenager; the elderly man I met told me the story of his life, how much he was worth and that when you are rich you are certainly going to heaven and that, that is a sign of God with you. He also said that, when you are poor you would be going to hell and that it was certainty that God hated you. He felt that this moneyless teenager could tell him nothing of worth. If I did not know better of God's word then probably I would have believed him and put my strength in life to pushing rather wealth than the God of wealth."

Psalms 9:23-24 and **Psalms 49:6-13** say that no man should glory in their riches (wealth) or wisdom acquired by reason of academics or any other opportunity except in the Lord because no man can by any means redeem his soul or another by his wealth or riches. In other words, we should be strong in the Lord and not in ourselves. One thing is common to the poor and the rich, they both die but their destiny is in the Lord's hands and not in their wealth or poverty **-Luke 16:19-31.**

Therefore, let me give you at least four other sources of strength:

- Strength in chariot and horses Psalms 20:7-8
- Strength in Self (The rich foolish man) Luke 12:16-21
- **Strength** in Demonic (fetish) spirit or powers—Deuteronomy 18:9-
- Strength in Wealth (The rich young ruler) Luke 18:18-27
- Strength in Man Jeremiah 17:5-8; Jude 1.

Know that all these other sources of strength may look good for a moment, but will surely fail and rob one of having an eternal effect with God. Put your strength in the Lord, all promised blessings will surely

How To Being Strong In The Lord:

Ephesians 6:10 ""Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of his might."

Romans 4:17-21 "(as it is written, I have made thee a father of many nations,) before him whom he believed, even God, who quickeneth the dead, and calleth those things which be not as though they were. 18 Who against hope believed in hope, that he might become the father of many nations; according to that which was spoken, So shall thy seed be. 19 And being not weak in faith, he considered not his own body now dead, when he was about an hundred years old, neither yet the deadness of Sara's womb: 20 he staggered not at the promise of God through unbelief; but was strong in faith, giving glory to God; 21 and being fully persuaded that, what he had promised, he was able also to perform."

1 Timothy 4:7-8 "But refuse profane and old wives' fables, and exercise thyself rather unto godliness. 8 For bodily exercise profiteth little: but godliness is profitable unto all things, having promise of the life that now is, and of that which is to come."

Galatians 1:3-5 "Grace be to you and peace from God the Father, and from our Lord Jesus Christ, 4 Who gave himself for our sins, that he might deliver us from this present evil world, according to the will of God and our Father: 5 To whom be glory for ever and ever. Amen"

God's intent delivers us from this present evil world through the deed of Christ, hence He gave us Christ Jesus our Lord as recorded in **Galatians 1:4**. Whatever you seem to be going through today, you need to know and understand that God's intent is to see you free and enjoy all of His promised blessings. God has made provision for you by His grace as made possible in **Galatians 1:3**, all you have to do is to be strong in His grace to actualise all these.

God's method may change, but His principles for our life to obtain His grace and promised blessings remain. To be strong in the Lord and in the power of His might is to be strong in Faith. It will be great to know that the enemy and cohorts are not actually after your property, marriage, finances, your business or career or such like; rather they are after your FAITH. The reason being that if they take all things from you as they did to Job in Job 19 note verses 24-26, and your faith is still intact, they is always the possibilities you will recover better than all that was initially taken away from you as showed in Job 42:10-17. But if your faith in God is stolen, destroyed and killed as John 10:10a indicates, the likelihood is that every other thing about you will still be stolen, destroyed and killed without any act of recovery. Hence to be strong in the Lord is to be strong in Faith.

4:7b-8 indicates. Because it possesses the promised of life here on earth and afterwards, meaning it has eternal value or substance. The scriptures speak of little faith meaning weak faith as found in the following - Mathew 6:30; 14:31; 16:8 and Luke 12:28. The opposite of weak is strong. Note that the scriptures did not say if you have a little faith like a mustard seed, but deed say if you have faith like a mustard seed. Faith is faith; the strength depends on the knowledge of grace it is operating on. Our God is strong. He is a strong tower, a citadel of protection and redemption.

At salvation and life, we have **the measure** and not **a measure** of faith as found in **Ephesians 2:8; Romans 12:3; 2 Corinthians 10:15** and **Ephesians 4:13** that God bestows or gives us. It is our prerogative to develop it into maturity until it comes to a place of strength. For it is by us using the measure of faith given to us by the Lord, understanding the principles of faith and then exercising those principles, that we can arrive at strong faith. That is the place where nothing will seem impossible for us and we can be victors and more than conquerors in every circumstance, because we are strong in the Lord, being strong in faith - **Mark 9:23; Luke 1:37** and **Matthew 17:19-21.**

What then is Faith which needs to be strong, how does it come and what are the implications of faith.

Faith is a spiritual entity and not a creed or doctrine but the Kingdom of God's spiritual, legal and vital tender to do life and live godly in the kingdom. Faith is acting on what you believe of God according to the scriptures. There is a great difference between believe and faith. They are like two sides of the same coin. It will be considered a fake or counterfeit if only one side has the inscriptions and the other did not if both are meant to have inscriptions. Faith needs belief and belief needs faith. In simple terms, if by taking prescribed medication by your doctor you will be well, and you believe in it, and you bought and kept it by you bedside, merely believing in it would not cure you until you take it. If you don't, you will die merely believing. But when you act on what you believe by taking the medication, you will be well and live for more years. In same way FAITH is acting on what you believe. It is the substance that is the cheque you are holding to make you believe that there is money in the bank even when you don't have it yet. A believing of the heart (spirit) and declaration of the mouth is faith - Hebrews 11:1 and Romans 10:6-10.

Faith comes and faith goes. Faith only comes by the hearing and hearing the word of God - **Romans 10:27**. Faith does not come by having heard. You need to continuously hear the word of God until there is an entrance of that word beyond your heard knowledge into your spirit man, then faith is activated to work - **Psalms 119:130; 2 Peter 1:11**.



Meaning the hearing of the written word, *logos*, as a result of the spoken, that is, the revealed word *Rhema*, which will then become flesh, that is, **the incarnate word**, the reality or substantial desire in hand - **John 1:1-5**; **14**. When there is no hearing of the word of God, then there is no activation of faith. *Are you hearing the word of God or listening to stories of men?*.

Some implication of Faith for your perusal can be found in the following scriptures - **Hebrews 11**; **Romans 4:17-21**; **Romans 14:23**; **Habak-kuk 2:4**; **Romans 1:17**; **Galatians 3:11**.

The Principles To Being Strong In The Lord By Strong Faith:

Principle 1: You need to know the reality of God's Word.

No word, no faith, no faith no God but religion or a form of godliness with no power - **2 Timothy 3:5**. You don't have to hope or think it is in the Bible. It is not by hoping about it or philosophizing about it or guessing it. God's word wont do you any good while on the pages of the Bible; but you need to get God's word off that page and down into your spirit being for it to work or to be activated to produce good in and out of you - **Matthew 22:29; 2 Timothy 2:15; 2 Timothy 4:15-17.**

Principle 2: You need to know the reality of your Redemption in Christ.

There are degrees of what seem like faith. No faith, little or weak faith, strong faith, great faith, growing faith, unfeigned faith, shipwrecked faith and more. Only by the strong faith can you actualise the reality of your redemption in Christ into your spirit being. You have to know the reality of your redemption in Christ not as a creed, not as a denominational dogmas or tenet, not as a traditional idea of religion and not as a philosophical dissertation but rather as a living reality. That is, you must come to know that you know that you know that you are redeemed or have been redeemed and you are a partaker of it. Meaning you are redeemed, you are not trying every Sunday to be redeemed neither are you processing to be redeemed - Colossians 1:13-14; Ephesians 1:7; Galatians 3:13-14. You need to be assured and insured of your redemption in Christ Jesus - Philemon 6.

Principle 3: You need to know the principle of the new creation.

You need to come to see yourself the way God's sees you, not the way or accreditation of men or by the values World. Knowing that the new creation has no past and there is no fishing or digging of the past in the sea of God's forgiveness and forgetfulness — **Micah 7:18-19.** See yourself as a new creation, that person or personali-

ty in Christ through the mirror of God's word. James 1:22-25; 2 Corinthians 5:17-21; Galatians 5:6; 6:14-15; Colossians 3:10-11 and Galatians 3:28. Knowing the principle of the new creation is you seeing the you in in you in the Spirit not in physical look - Job 32:8 33:4; Proverbs 20:27; 1 Thessalonians 5:23; Hebrews 4:12.

• Principle 4: You need to know the reality of your righteousness in Christ.

Righteousness is a gift. It's not earned by any of your efforts, it is God bestowment upon you, the ability to stand before Him without guilt and shame. Romans 1:16-17; Romans 10:10; 2 Corinthians 5:17-21; Romans 5:17-19.

• Principle 5: You need to know the reality of the Indwelling Holy Spirit.

No Holy Spirit, no knowing of the person of God. You may know about God but can't know God except by realisation of the working of the Holy Spirit indwelling in you. Only by the inditing of the indwelling Spirit of God that you can actualise your strong faith of being strong in the Lord. 1 John 4:4; 2 Corinthians 6:16; Colossians 1:27; John 1:12-14; 1 Corinthians 3:16-17; 1 Corinthians 6:19-20; Romans 8:1-2, 9-11, 14-16; Galatians 5:25; Acts 1:8; Luke 24:49; Joel 2:28-31.

• Principle 6: You need to know the reality of the authority in the name of Jesus as your possession.

You can't just live life anyhow. God has given you rights into His bosom and the master key which is the name of Jesus. You need to develop strong faith in that name to ensure you live and reign in life. Philippians 2:9-11; Luke 10:17-19; John 1:12; Acts 1:1-8; Matthew 28:18; Mark 16:15-20.


Being Strong In The Lord To Do Exploit:



It is in this strength that God cause you to do exploit of great triumph.

Isaiah 28:5-6 says that in that day when you choose to be strong in the Lord, the Lord will give you the strength to turn the battle to the gate and not within your territory. There is always strength for those who choose to turn the battle of life to the gate and not those who choose to give in to the enemy and cohorts. God is a strong and great God. As a lion does not give birth to a rat and God have made you god, don't settle for little, go and do exploits, that is the scripture **- John 10:30-35; Psalms 82:8 and Genesis 3:5.**







But they won't be put off just like that. We are re-fencing the yard they tell us. "Brilliant" I say. Well its 6 months later - same old fence. It's not my fence so I have no qualms about it.

Seeing the natural through spiritual eyes

In another area two weeks ago a part of the turf was removed fully. All day it took. I can't tell what the plan is - but must be big right?! Not sure now because on the opposite side of the garden where the turf once was, the ground is being lowered by digging even more. This is just about a fifth of the ground done before all are indoors again for a long while.





In another area are once beautiful lounging chairs. Obviously bought with good intention but they too are unrecognisable. Now they are torn,



grey (once black) and rusty. They have been left uncared for, not protected from the elements. Why am I going on and on about this unkempt garden you may wonder. Here's the reason . . .






