He also has planted eternity in men's hearts and minds [a divinely implanted sense of a purpose working through the ages which nothing under the sun but God alone can satisfy], yet so that men cannot find out what God has done from the beginning to the end." (Amplified)

Prophetic Declaration:

Matthew 6:25-34 "Therefore I tell you, stop being [a]perpetually uneasy (anxious and worried) about your life, what you shall eat or what you shall drink; or about your body, what you shall put on. Is not life greater [in quality] than food, and the body [far above and more excellent] than clothing? 26 Look at the birds of the air; they neither sow nor reap nor gather into barns, and yet your heavenly Father keeps feeding them. Are you not worth much more than they? 27 And who of you by worrying and being anxious can add one unit of measure (cubit) to his stature or to the [b]span of his life? 28 And why should you be anxious about clothes? Consider the lilies of the field and [c]learn thoroughly how they grow; they neither toil nor spin. 29 Yet I tell you, even Solomon in all his [d]magnificence (excellence, dignity, and grace) was not arrayed like one of these. 30 But if God so clothes the grass of the field, which today is alive and green and tomorrow is tossed into the furnace, will He not much more surely clothe you, O you of little faith? 31 Therefore do not worry and be anxious, saying, What are we going to have to eat? or, What are we going to have to drink? or, What are we going to have to wear? 32 For the Gentiles (heathen) wish for and crave and diligently seek all these things, and your heavenly Father knows well that you need them all. 33 But seek ([e]aim at and strive after) first of all His kingdom and His righteousness ([f]His way of doing and being right), and then all these things [g]taken together will be given you besides. 34 So do not worry or be anxious about tomorrow, for tomorrow will have worries and anxieties of its own. Sufficient for each day is its own trouble." (Amplified)

This is your month to appropriate your REDEMPTION rights and privileges wholly and completely to ensure that you live a wholesome life. God wants you to live a wholesome life; a life that is effectual and efficient, meaning a life of actualising productivity and maximising your God given opportunity to resource in terms of - **Time, Effort and Finance**.

Worry and anxiety are as result of fear. Fear is the devil's policing agent that goes about confronting, harassing and intimidating us in our day to day activities and efforts in achieving the basic necessities of life - **Food**, **Clothing and Shelter.** As important as they are, they are not the ab-

solute life givers and sustenance that we deem them to be. In spite of any noble intention of achieving these basics, crime and corruption stem from the desire to achieve by any means possible.

These matters - **Food, Clothing and Shelter** - are costing individuals and nations huge bills today because of craving for even more than one need. to make this happen in one's life by every available chance and opportunity. People and governments are exploited in a bid to have, hold and hoard. Even within families, you find individuals and groups undermining each other in order to prove a point or even have more than the other. But think about it – are these the issues that give life?

Matthew 6:25-31 brings us to a place where we can realise that which is important and make decisions on how we see food clothing and shelter. The questions being put before us in **verses 25 -27** are whether being concerned about matters of living a fulfilled and exciting life are more important than worrying on matters of food and drink in all our plans, purpose and pursuits. Also, if matters that make our body healthier are not more vital than the clothes that we crave for. Many years ago, I remember being so fixated on how "stuff" was placed, positioned or looked after. When I say 'stuff', I mean furniture, clothes, food, household items etc. This focus and fixation on stuff may cause a breakdown in family communication and is no healthy way of living a fulfilled life.

The objective of this month theme, "**The Path of Life**", is to lead us to those important choices of life that the heavens consider more important. God wants you to have a wholesome life; a life of grace in your whole spirit, soul and body as **1 Thessalonians 5:23 and Hebrews 4:12-13** would want us to know. Today, I make this prophetic declaration that:



PREAMBLE: The Path of Life

March is the third month of the year. **Three signifies wholeness**, **completeness**, **perfection and maturity**. The month reminds me also that there are three unified persons in one God – God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Ghost. More so, our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ, raised in resurrection for our redemption from the grave, happened on the third day. When I consider all these and more, I am bound to conclude that in this month called March something very significant is about to come your way, hence the theme – **The Path To Life** "*The Achievers Path To Wholesome Living*". A month in which you can step up your position in the Lord to actualise and experience wholeness, completeness, perfection and maturity in grace and in all things that pertain to living life and godliness as God created and intended us to be.

2 Peter 1:2-4 "Grace and peace be multiplied unto you through the knowledge of God, and of Jesus our Lord, **3 according as his divine power hath given unto us all things that pertain unto life and godliness, through the knowledge of him that hath called us to glory and virtue:** 4 whereby are given unto us exceeding great and precious promises: that by these ye might be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that *is in the world through lust."*

Ephesians 2:10 "For we are God's [own] handiwork (His workmanship), [a]recreated in Christ Jesus, [born anew] that we may do those good works which God predestined (planned beforehand) for us [taking paths which He prepared ahead of time], that we should walk in them [living the good life which He prearranged and made ready for us to live]" (Amplified)

God in redemption as **2 Peter 1:2-4** and **Ephesians 2:10** indicate, has by His divine act of creation and power made available all things, which include food, clothing and shelter. Our living the wholesome life and staying godly will not be obstructed if we follow His path of life. Many times the eagerness to have the basic matters for living has derailed many in the kingdom from the basic matters of life; and instead of enjoying God's gracious abundance as in John 10:10, we struggle through life despite all those things that are within our reach anyway, because we have missed the actual path of life which the Lord has created us to walk in it - **Ephesians 2:10 (Amplified)**.

We must know that there is a great difference between **'The Path for life'** and **'The Path of Life'**.

The path for life is our own making of life's path which can short live us, perspire us, stress us up and drain us eventually without peace of mind and the joy of having it all in terms of the basics - food, clothing and shelter. Hence there are many rich or well to do folks committing suicide today and others into drugs and all sorts of drunkenness and excessive vices despite all they claim to have worked, cele-

brated, inherited or acclaimed by force as path for life. This essence for life is limited, can be crushing on its own, can be frustrating as it's an illusion and confusion of all sorts. It can wear us out in the pursuit to have it all. We need **the path of life** to sustain the **path for life** if we must have a reason to be truly fulfilled and complete with wholesome living as God has created us to be in Christ Jesus.

The path of life is the life divinely arranged as the pathway to experience a wholesome life, full of peace, sound mind, complete and fulfilling in spite of all things, such as: Food, Clothing & Shelter - Romans 8:35-39; Matthew 6:25-34. A life governed and ordered by God for the good of all in Christ Jesus; and it's a life without prejudice or vices to make one what one is born of God to be. The source of sinews of the being is of God and not of man as the following scriptures indicate - Ephesians 2:10 (Amplified), Proverbs 20:27; Job 32:8; Job 33:4 and Genesis 2:7; 1 Corinthians 2:9-16. This life refreshes from within, that is, inside out, by the indwelling Spirit of creation that created the human spirit and not by the bottles of champagne or class that we belong to. This human spirit is created to submit to God, serve Him and worship Him in spirit and truth – Isaiah 28:9-12; Ephesians 6:18; Philippians 3:3 and John 4:24. When we live and walk in the path of life which is of Christ, living the path for life will become stress-less, worry-less and yoke-less; it becomes a life with complete fulfilling with sound mind and peace in the Holy Ghost as Romans 14:17 says "for the kingdom of God is not meat and drink; but righteousness, and peace, and joy in the Holy Ghost.".

Psalms 16:11 "*Thou wilt shew me the path of life:* in thy presence is fulness of joy; at thy right hand there are pleasures for evermore."

Philippians 1:21 "For to me, living means living for Christ, and dying is even better." (NLT)

Acts 17:28 "For in him we live, and move, and have our being; as certain also of your own poets have said, For we are also his offspring."

Apostle Paul in the letters of **Acts 17:28** and **Philippians 1:21** indicate strongly what it means to have life and live or what true life and wholesome living is on this side of heaven. He indicated that we all in essence live, move and have our being in God and true living of life is living of God, in and for Christ. His package of REDEMPTION for us indicates how we need to understand this path of life and wholesome living in order for our faith to be effectual and efficient – **Philemon 6**. This AFD March 2014 Edition will offer the path of life for you as the **Psalms 16:11** above indicates. The Intention is for you to know and understand the difference between **the path of life** and **the path for life** and to be able to have a reason to live a wholesome life.

Psalms 16:11 being the context scripture from where the theme of the month is being built up has two major principles of the path of Life

The path for life



PRINCIPLE 1:

THE PATH OF LIFE: In His Presence!

Psalms 16:11 "Thou wilt shew me the path of life: in thy presence is fulness of joy. . ."

Mark 1:35 "And in the morning, rising up a great while before day, he went out, and departed into a **solitary place**, and there prayed."

Luke 9:28-29 "And it came to pass about an eight days after these sayings, **he took Peter and John and James, and went up into a mountain to pray.** 29 And as he prayed, the fashion of his countenance was altered, and his raiment was white and glistering."

Hebrews 5:7-9 "So also Christ glorified not himself to be made an high priest; but he that said unto him, Thou art my Son, to day have I begotten thee. 6 As he saith also in another place, Thou art a priest for ever after the order of Melchisedec. 7 Who in the days of his flesh, when he had offered up prayers and supplications with strong crying and tears unto him that was able to save him from death, and was heard in that he feared; 8 Though he were a Son, yet learned he obedience by the things which he suffered; 9 And being made perfect, he became the author of eternal salvation unto all them that obey him."

Today everybody wants to succeed, excel and live a wholesome life. But life is far more than by chance and effort pursuits alone. In the kingdom of God there is a way and law of life – **Romans 8:2**; the way and law of life through which things works for those who belong to the Kingdom of God. The way and law of life that God has set as a pattern to make us live and walk complete, perfect and mature; to bring us to fruition in all life endeavours and in our cause on earth. A way and law of life to make complete and fulfil in all that concerns us in Christ and the kingdom - **Philippians 1:6; Colossians 4:17.**

To enhance our cause in life on earth and in order to have a fulfilling and complete good, there is something we learn from the life of Christ Jesus in humanity; that is, in order to actualise a wholesome life on this side of heaven.

1 John 4:17 "Herein is our love made perfect, that we may have boldness in the day of judgment: **because as he is, so are we in this world**"

Matthew 6:10 "Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven."

Jesus in humanity was a man that cherished God's presence at all times. His cherished yearn of God's presence is the marked principle of the path of life. In order to experience the path of life with God we must cherish God's presence. Jesus at the dawn of His ministerial work on

earth made the disciples to understand that their first primary job was **to be with Him**, and after that, He could send them forth to preach the gospel, heal the sick people and do the good and great work of God as indicated in scripture below.

Mark 3:13-15 "And he goeth up into a mountain, and calleth unto him whom he would: and they came unto him. 14 And he ordained twelve, **that they should be with him**, and that he might send them forth to preach, 15 and to have power to heal sicknesses, and to cast out devils."

Jesus knew that until they had the life they could not preach the life. That until the disciples understood what the path of life entailed, they could not give such hope and grace to others. You can only offer eternal virtue that will make a unique difference on earth to someone else if you have it. It is through such experiences and convictions of the path of life through being in Christ Jesus' presence that embolden **Apostle John** in his epistle writings. He was bold to make known his assurance and conviction of faith. He preached the same to others in order for their joy to be full as in the scriptures below.

1 John 1:1-4 "That which was from the beginning, which we have heard, which we have seen with our eyes, which we have looked upon, and our hands have handled, of the Word of life; 2 (for the life was manifested, and we have seen it, and bear witness, and shew unto you that eternal life, which was with the Father, and was manifested unto us;) 3 that which we have seen and heard declare we unto you, that ye also may have fellowship with us: and truly our fellowship is with the Father, and with his Son Jesus Christ. **4** And these things write we unto you, that your joy may be full."


Jesus had to live His life in 'the path of life', which is, through being always in God's presence as shown in **Mark 1:35** even though He is the son of God as indicated in **Hebrews 5:7-9**; It was in walking on this path of life in humanity that enabled Him to experience a wholesome, complete, fulfilling, matured, perfect sound mind and in peace in His earthly ministerial cause. The scripture writing of one of such experiences of Christ Jesus was in **Luke 9:28-29 (28-36)**. This experience of God's presence, the scripture refers to as the mountain of transfiguration. As He was in God's presence, the grace and glory of the living Father God overshadowed Jesus and those that were with Him. An experience that the disciples with Him where in awe of and then resolved to build a tent there and forgo the life on earth. That gives us a glimpse of the awesomeness of being in God's presence. Today, with the indwelling Holy Spirit in us we can experience God's presence anytime, anywhere and anyhow. **Let's give it a go!**

Moses had similar experiences in many ways in the cause of His ministerial walk with God on earth. One such moving experience is in **Exodus 24:9-18**, where the Lord told him how he would build the tabernacle or the temple of worship. Today it's becoming rare to see minis-

ters and Christians in leadership spend sufficient time in God's presence to get direction on how to build the people (temples of the Holy Ghost) that the Lord had committed into their hands to look after them well – **Proverbs 27:23**. In order to experience uniqueness in life – **marriage**, **business, career, governance and more** – you must walk in that path of life wherein you can spend time in – **God's Presence** – to accomplish what you are made to be in Him – **Ephesians 2:10** (Amplified)

IN HIS PRESENCE: The Fulness of Joy.

Psalms 16:11 ". . . In thy presence is fulness of joy. . ."

John 15:10-12 "If ye keep my commandments, ye shall abide in my love; even as I have kept my Father's commandments, and abide in his love. 11 These things have I spoken unto you, **that my** joy might remain in you, and that your joy might be full. 12 This is my commandment, That ye love one another, as I have loved you."

1 John 1:1-4 ". . . 4 And these things write we unto you, that your joy may be full."

1 Peter 1:1-9 ". . . Grace unto you, and peace, be multiplied. 3 Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, which according to his abundant mercy hath begotten us again unto a lively hope by the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead . . . **8 whom having not seen, ye love; in whom, though now ye see him not, yet believing, ye rejoice with joy unspeakable and full of glory:** 9 receiving the end of your faith, even the salvation of your souls."

Joy is a feeling of great pleasure and happiness; remarked or expressed in other words as delight, great pleasure, joyfulness, jubilation, triumph, exultation, rejoicing, happiness, gladness, glee, exhilaration, ebullience, exuberance, elation, euphoria, bliss, ecstasy, transports of delight, rapture, radiance; enjoyment, gratification, felicity; cloud nine, seventh heaven, ravishment, jocundity, "whoops of joy", humorous, joyousness, pleasure, source of pleasure, delight, treat, thrill and more. One great remark I have known of God in life and ministry is that he wants to see His children happily blessed and with joy indescribable. If in the world, governments at all levels want their staff, representatives or ambassadors and all who work on their behalf to be well treated and looked after, God will not be foreign in dignifying with joyfulness His people who spend quality time in Him and with Him – **2 Corinthians 5:20**.

Another great remark of being in God's presence as the path of life, is having and living joyfully as indicated in **Psalms 16:11**. **1 Peter 1:8, 1 John 1:4** and **John 15:11** show how much God's intent is for us to be joyful. Unspeakable and indescribable joy for you all the time is God's intent; be it in being single in a relationship, marriage, career, business, governance and more. God wants you to experience joy. God's kind of joy, which is as a result of you being available in His presence; walking

in the path of life as God had offered us all in Christ Jesus, the Lord. To buttress this resultant effect of being in His presence, which is the – **fullness of Joy** – let's consider two important acts of grace to give us such an effect.

• Waiting Upon The Lord

Isaiah 40:31 "But they that **wait upon the Lord** shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint." **Romans 12:6-8** "Having then gifts differing according to the grace that is given to us, whether prophecy, let us prophesy according to the proportion of faith; 7 or ministry, let us wait on our ministering: or he that teacheth, on teaching; 8 or he that exhorteth, on exhortation: he that giveth, let him do it with simplicity; he that ruleth, with diligence; he that sheweth mercy, with cheerfulness."

Waiting on the Lord is a great act of faith. In God's presence is the way to access the life of God that offers the fullness of joy. Waiting could be in the form of fasting and prayers – Matthew 6:5-18. We do know that fasting does not change God or his will, but it brings us to a place where God can transfigure us to be receptive of the fulness of His grace, blessings, deliverance, mercy and joy forever more – Malachi 3:6 and Isaiah 58. There is a tremendous fullness of joy, power and great result when such events happen in our Life. Fasting and prayers as a way of waiting on the Lord is to make one readily available for God's blessing and grace.

Isaiah 40:31 says that they, that is - whoever waits upon the Lord's presence shall experience the following:

- They shall renew their strength
- They shall mount up with wings as eagles
- They shall run, and not be weary
- They shall walk, and not faint.

Having your strength renewed every day will elevate you from stress to rest. Eagles stretch out in response to the movement of the wind. The wind symbolises the Holy Spirit. The eagle effortlessly flies above mountains of limitations simply because they don't flap their wings but mount (stretch) it out knowing the direction of the wind. In the same scenario, through waiting upon the Lord, the Holy Spirit elevates you. Hence you can run in faith not being weary as one that is beating the air and having no results as **Apostle Paul** says in **1 Corinthians 9:26**, but as the one who walk in faith and does not faint – John 3:8; Jeremiah12:5; Proverbs 24:10 and Luke 18:1.

Finally on this act of waiting is when considering God's given plans, purposes and pursuits in your life as indicated in **Romans 12:6-8.** Whether you are called into spiritual ministry or called into any form of career in life, by the virtue of being a child of God, you will always need the grace to do the services required, hence the need to wait on

the Lord for the enabling grace. Waiting upon the Lord will save you from stress, struggle, complaints, murmuring and such likes in your field of services to God and humanity. I therefore challenge you today to see the need to wait in the Lord's presence that you might obtain the fullness of joy, and to be able to offer joyful services to God and mankind in return.

Tarrying At The Wine

Proverbs 23:29-30 "Who hath woe? who hath sorrow? who hath contentions? who hath babbling? who hath wounds without cause? who hath redness of eyes? 30 **they that tarry long at the wine**; they that go to seek mixed wine."

Acts2:1-21 "... 12And they were all amazed, and were in doubt, saying one to another, What meaneth this? 13 Others mocking said, These men are full of new wine. 14 But Peter, standing up with the eleven, lifted up his voice, and said unto them, Ye men of Judæa, and all ye that dwell at Jerusalem, be this known unto you, and hearken to my words: 15 for these are not drunken, as ye suppose, seeing it is but the third hour of the day. 16 But this is that which was spoken by the prophet Joel; 17 And it shall come to pass in the last days, saith God, I will pour out of my Spirit upon all flesh: and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams. ... ""

Psalms 104:15 "And **wine** that maketh glad the heart of man, and oil to make his face to shine, and bread which strengtheneth man's heart."

Tarrying in God's presence has sometimes been misinterpreted to mean only tarrying for the Holy Spirit as the Lord Christ Jesus said in **Acts 1:8** and **Luke 24:49** which eventually were for that moment and not for all time - (another subject of thought).

However, in the context of the theme, tarrying here is about you spending time with the Holy Spirit, the chief director and executor of God's purpose on earth through His Church, that is, you and I – **Romans 8:1-27; John 14:8-21; 16:12-15.** The Apostle in receiving the outpouring of the Holy Spirit, were likened to have being drunken with the new wine which Apostle Peter in response to their ignorance to their experience in **Acts 2:1-21** indicated that they have just being baptised with Holy Spirit of promised as in **Joel 2:28-31** as in other scriptures accordingly - **Luke 24:49; John 7:37-39; Luke 11:9-13.**

The Apostles honoured their first experience as we see in **Acts 1:8**, however in the course of time in life and ministry had to tarry again in the wine as **Acts 4** would indicate. **Acts 4** experience was to receive the boldness and grace to keep them keeping on in their God given plans, purposes and pursuits as a group, and to receive the enabling power and instruction to deal with their circumstances at that time. So, tarrying may not necessary mean for a time but something we can do from time to time as occasions warrant us to in order to refresh the

grace of the wine, in us, upon and with us. This shows that once baptised does not mean filled forever, but requires staying with the wine over and over again to accomplish divine plans in and through us that we may have the kind of results apostle received as thus here:

Acts 4:31 "And when they had prayed, the place was shaken where they were assembled together; and they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and they spake the word of God with boldness."

Ephesians 5:18-21 "And be not drunk with wine, *wherein is excess; but be filled with the Spirit;* 19 *speaking to yourselves in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord;* 20 giving thanks always for all things unto God and the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ; 21 submitting *yourselves one to another in the fear of God."*

In the writing of the psalmist, **Psalms 104:15** indication of the WINE, OIL and BREAD can be deduced to mean that the Wine symbolises the Holy Spirit, the Oil as the Anointing and the Bread as the Word of God; Which in essence when you consider Christ's experience of tarrying in the Father's presence, it was an act led by the Holy Spirit as Matthew 4:1-11 and Luke 4:1-21 indicates. Jesus was led by the Holy Spirit, the Wine, which is a symbol of the Father's presence that He might receive the oil and bread as the book of Matthew and Luke indicated. From the Lord Christ Jesus' experience and the outwork of that experience in His life and ministerial work on earth, we can learn of the importance of tarrying in the wine, the Holy Spirit. This exemplifies how we can receive grace from the Father God as touching the various areas of our life as it affects God's plans, purposes and pursuits. We can't be engaged in God's work and not have continuous fellowship with God the Holy Spirit, the chair of God's plans, purposes and pursuits on earth in all of human phases of doing life and godliness. It pays to draw near to God as He will draw near towards us.

James 4:8 "Draw nigh to God, and he will draw nigh to you. Cleanse your hands, ye sinners; and purify your hearts, ye double minded."

Proverbs 23:29-30 gives us a powerful understanding of the transformation and resultant effect that takes place when one tarries at the wine. From the negative implication of tarrying on the wine as in the scripture of Proverbs stated, we can see what the positive effect could be when we tarry on the Holy Spirit, the wine that **Psalms 104:15** says it makes our heart (spirit being) glad and joyful. This is reiterated in **Ephesians 5:18-21** "And be not drunk with wine, wherein is excess; but be filled with the Spirit; 19 speaking to yourselves in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord; 20 giving thanks always for all things unto God

PRINCIPLE 2:

THE PATH OF LIFE: At His Right Hand

Psalms 16:11 "*Thou wilt shew me the path of life:* . . . At thy right hand there are pleasures for evermore."

Ephesians 1:15-23 "Wherefore I also, after I heard of your faith in the Lord Jesus, and love unto all the saints, 16 cease not to give thanks for you, making mention of you in my prayers; 17 that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give unto you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of him: 18 the eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that ye may know what is the hope of his calling, and what the riches of the glory of his inheritance in the saints, 19 and what is the exceeding greatness of his power to us-ward who believe, according to the working of his mighty power, 20 which he wrought in Christ, when he raised him from the dead, and set him at his own right hand in the heavenly places, 21 far above all principality, and power, and might, and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this world, but also in that which is to come: 22 and hath put all things under his feet, and gave him to be the head over all things to the church, 23 which is his body, the fulness of him that filleth all in all." Ephesians 2:4-8 "But God, who is rich in mercy, for his great love wherewith he loved us, 5 even when we were dead in sins, hath quickened us together with Christ, (by grace ye are saved;) 6 and hath raised us up together, and made us sit together in heavenly places in Christ Jesus: 7 that in the ages to come he might shew the exceeding riches of his grace in his kindness toward us through Christ Jesus. 8 For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God"

Hebrews 12: 2 "Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith; who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, **and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God**" (Further reading - Luke 22:69; Acts 2:33; 5:31; 7:55-56; Romans 8:34; 2 Corinthians 6:7; Colossians 3:1; Hebrews 10:12; 1 Peter 3:11).

The scripture has several usage of the term in KJV translated as "right" and or the "right hand" most importantly in reference to God. In some cases it's about speaking of what is right to wrong, and to what be just or what conforms to an established expectation, and to a place of honor or authority. An example as to what is right or right hand that can be typified is in the case of sharing an inheritance and the appointment of grace. This could be drawn as what Jacob in **Genesis 48:13-14** did when he put forth his right hand to divide the blessings to Joseph's sons – *Ephraim and Manasseh* – before he died.

Being at the right hand of God could be likened to when a person of high position in life put someone on his right hand and gives them equal honour with himself and recognises them as possessing equal dignity and authority. This is what it means for us in being a heirs and joint-heirs with Christ Jesus as in **Romans 8:16-17.** This is also what the Apostle Paul writes of Jesus Christ in **Ephesians 1:19-21** and of us in **Ephesians 2:4-10** sitting in high places with Christ Jesus at the right hand of God our Father. Here we see God exalting Jesus above all others by seating Him at the right hand of the Father. This is what makes **Philemon 6** a memorable scripture because it gives insight and foresight on how our faith can be effectual in us walking in the path that acknowledges all that Jesus has done in us to enable us to actualise the fullness of God in our lives.

The term "God's right hand" in prophecy refers to the Messiah to whom is given the power and authority to subdue His enemies as Psalm 110:1; Psalm 118:16 and Matthew 22:44 indicate. In Matthew 22:41-45, Jesus questions the Pharisees about who they think the "Christ" or the Messiah is.

Matthew 22:41-45 "While the Pharisees were gathered together, Jesus asked them, Saying, What think ye of Christ? Whose son is He? They say unto him, The Son of David. He saith unto them, How then doth David in spirit call him Lord, saying, The LORD said unto my Lord, **Sit thou on my right hand**, till I make Thine enemies thy footstool? If David then call Him Lord, how is He his son?"

The position of the Messiah is at God's right hand. The fact that Jesus Christ is at the "right hand of God" was a sign to the disciples that Jesus had indeed gone to heaven. In **John 16:7-15**, Jesus told the disciples that He had to go away and He would send the Holy Spirit. So the coming of the Holy Spirit in the upper room on the day of Pentecost as in **Acts 2:1-13** was positive proof that Jesus was indeed in heaven and seated at the right hand of God. This is confirmed in **Romans 8:34** where the Apostle Paul writes that Christ is sitting at God's right hand making intercession for us.

Therefore, what we can say is that at "God's right hand", the Messiah, the LORD Jesus Christ, He is of equal position, honor, power and authority with God as before humanity - **John 1:1-5, 14**. The fact that Christ is "sitting" as indicated in **Ephesians 1:20** and **Ephesians 2:6** refers to the fact that His work of redemption is done and we His church has He highly exalted to sit with Him at the right hand of God the Father in the heavenly places. It thus means that being at God's right hand is being with Christ. Being with Christ is being righteous; and it indicates our being able to acknowledge and receive in fullness the righteousness of God as done in us by Christ Jesus as indicated in the scriptures below;



The position of the Messiah is at God's right hand. The fact that Jesus Christ is at the "right hand of God" was a sign to the disciples that Jesus had indeed gone to heaven.

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knew no sin; that we might be made **the righteousness** of God in him."

Romans 5:17-21 "For if by one man's offence death reigned by one; much more they which receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness shall reign in life by one, Jesus Christ.) 18 Therefore as by the offence of one judgment came upon all men to condemnation; even so by the righteousness of one the free gift came upon all men unto justification of life. 19 For as by one man's disobedience many were made sinners, so by the obedience of one shall many be made righteous. 20 Moreover the law entered, that the offence might abound. But where sin abounded, grace did much more abound: 21 that as sin hath reigned unto death, even so might grace reign through righteousness unto eternal life by Jesus Christ our Lord"

Righteousness exalts, it positions one for God's grace and blessings -**Proverbs 14:34**. The kingdom of our God is about righteousness, that is, our being able to stand tall and stay strong in the Lord and in the power of His Word and in the position wherein God has set us free in Christ Jesus our Lord – **Romans 14:17**. A position of identification with all that Christ has done in us that gives us the right to stand before our God without wrath, shame or guilt; It is where we are able to withstand the enemy of our faith in Christ Jesus thereby not giving him the room to accuse us and to hinder us of our place in God through our Lord Jesus Christ – **Ephesians 6:14**. If you've wandered away from Christ, it's time to return now in order to experience the grace of God by being at the right hand of God as the scripture intends for you in **Psalms 16:11**. **HIS RIGHT HAND: Pleasures For Evermore**

Psalms 16:11 "Thou wilt shew me the path of life: . . . At thy right hand there are pleasures for evermore."

Luke 12:30-32 "For all these things do the nations of the world seek after: and your Father knoweth that ye have need of these things. 31 But rather seek ye the kingdom of God; and all these things shall be added unto you. 32 **Fear not, little flock; for it is your Father's good pleasure to give you the kingdom**."

Psalms 35:27-28 "Let them shout for joy, and be glad, that favour my righteous cause: yea, let them say continually, **Let the Lord be magnified, which hath pleasure in the prosperity of his servant**. 28 And my tongue shall speak of thy righteousness and of thy praise all the day long."

John 10:10 "The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: **I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.**"

John 10:10 ""The thief comes only in order to steal and kill and destroy. **I came that they may have and enjoy life, and have it** *in abundance (to the full, till it [a]overflows)." (Amplified)*

God wants us to have pleasure and not pressure. Have you noticed that people use the phrases I am stressed, I'm under pressure, I am emotionally drained etcetera in order to emphasise that they may be under-

going a challenging time in their life? These phrases have been overused to an extent that leaves them misunderstood. We as God's children who want to achieve things as achievers in Christ must come to the understanding that when we stand at the right hand of God we are certain that the Lord's good will come to us. We don't need to make our case appeal to men but to stand on the unadulterated and uncompromising word of God that has such power to enable us have pleasure in the midst of pressure, stress and more.


Luke 12:30-32 and Jeremiah 29:11 gives us a very great remark of the Father God heart and thoughts towards us; it's - fear not, that is worry not and do not be anxious for your life and living as one without hope and life in this world because, - the Father's pleasure is to give us the good of the Kingdom as we seek Him first. This profound statement is strong enough to take any person from stress to rest, from failure to success, from disappointment to appointment, from shame to fame and from a beggarly receiver to a giver. To enhance this statement of grace, Psalms 35:27-28 indicates that God does not only want us to give us pleasure, He also takes pleasure in seeing us succeed in life. He wants to see us triumph and win in life. When God stands by you in all plans, purposes and pursuits, why should you worry or be anxious of how your life will go. Therefore, wake up from your stupor and see the glorious future that the Lord has in plan for you when you walk in His path of life for you as He has ordained - Ephesians 2:10.

John 10:10, helps me to conclude this section, that is, to let you know that God has given you a super abundant life through our Lord Jesus Christ. He wants you to have life and have the pleasure that accompanies life so that you can enjoy His grace. All you need to do is just to walk in the Path of Life as in **Psalms 16:11** and **Ephesians 2:10**, then the rest is of God to bless you accordingly at His pleasure as promised.

PATH OF LIFE: Wholesome Living

1 Thessalonians 5:23 "And the very God of peace sanctify you **wholly**; and I pray God your **whole spirit and soul and body** be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ." **Hebrews 4:9-13** "There remaineth therefore **a rest to the peo-**

There is place of rest for the people of God as God rested – **Genesis 2:1-3.** Moreover, God wants His children to have a wholesome life and not being crushed, just as it's written in **1 Thessalonians 5:23** and **Proverbs 18:14.** God wants to see your whole being – spirit, soul and body enjoy wholesome living until Christ returns. Hence the way we do life as God's children must be in line with the path of life that He has set before us in the Holy writ by the Holy Spirit to make it all possible for us – **Mark 9:23.** Our Lord is not pleasured when we have sound spirit but troubled in our mind and sick in our body; or great in our body but sick in our spirit and battered in our mind; or great in our mind but hopeless in our spirit and hospitalised in our body. The Lord God wants to see you wholesome indeed, hence the need to walk in the path of life He has set before us to make it possible.

From **Hebrews 4:9-13**, we know that there is a place of wholeness, a place of rest for the people of God. But it equally exhorts us to labour, that is, make faith effort to enter into this rest of wholeness, which is made possible by the Word of God. The same scripture says that God's Word has the power to diagnose our spirit, soul and body in such a way that we can be able to do and make life wholesome as earlier explained from **1 Thessalonian 5:23**. It is your prerogative to labour and feed on the Word of God and to enrich your whole being – spirit, soul and body by the wholesome Word; and in such a state of wholesome feeding that you can make yourself walk in the path of life with ease wherein the blessings of God lie, that is - the good success, as endorsed in the following scriptures but not limited - **Joshua 1:8; 2 Timothy 2:15; 1 Thessalonians 4:11 and 2 Timothy 3:14-17**.

To ensure that one is able to have refreshing rest that is wholesome, you need the Blessed Holy Spirit to lead you in this path of life. Those who are led by the Holy Spirit are the children of God, **Romans 8:14-16** tells us. One major private life to give attention to strongly as to enjoying God's presence and being at His right hand, is praying in the Spirit. That is the refreshing that **Isaiah 28:9-12** wants you to know and understand, as the scripture says that it's with stammering tongue shall the Lord speak to His people so that they may hear Him audibly and articulately. When you are weak and tired, when your body is frayed and you seem so weak in mind and emotion to continue, praying in the Spirit (speaking forth in tongues) is the way back to stay in tune with the heavens; and to keep up in the Father's presence to receive grace for a wholesome life and living in trouble times – **Proverbs**

18:14; 1 Corinthians 14:4, 15, 39. Praying in the Spirit will edify, booster and synergises your faith and keeps you strong in holy and righteous path of life, prepared for the Lord's gracious works in and through you.

Jude 1:20 "But ye, beloved, **building up** yourselves on your most holy faith, **praying in the Holy Ghost**"

Jude 1:20 "But you, beloved, **build yourselves up** [founded] on your most holy faith [[a]make progress, rise like an edifice higher and higher], **praying in the Holy Spirit**" (Amplified

Ephesians 6:18 "*Praying always* with all prayer and supplication **in the Spirit**, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints."

Ephesians 6:18 "*Pray at all times* (on every occasion, in every season) *in the Spirit*, with all [manner of] prayer and entreaty. To that end keep alert and watch with strong purpose and perseverance, interceding in behalf of all the saints (God's consecrated people)." (Amplified

FINALLY:

Psalms 16:11 "*Thou wilt shew me the path of life:* in thy presence is fulness of joy; at thy right hand there are pleasures for evermore."

When we walk in the path of life, our path as the justified of the Loud, will ever keep shining until the job, the day, the expectation is done. God wants you to experience wholeness, be able to live and accomplish things in life, live a fulfilling life and be completely awesome. This is what Christ has done for us. I do believe that as the justified one in Christ, that you can make your darkness come to light by walking in the path of life wherein Christ has made you free and free indeed. **Proverbs 23:18; Philippians 1:6.**



Just What The Doctor Ordered!

Proverbs 4:20–22 "*My* son, attend to my words; consent and submit to my sayings. Let them not depart from your sight; keep them in the center of your heart. For they are life to those who find them, healing and health to all their flesh."

In the Hebrew, health in **verse 22** is translated 'medicine'. God has given us a prescription for our bodies – pertaining to our salvation – which is health (physical and spiritual), prosperity,

One dose will not do. Liken this to medication prescribed by the Doctor for you. You usually have to take a full course of the medication before it takes the desired effect on your body. There are a certain number of times a day that you would have to take the tablets and a certain amount too. Well the Bible says that we ought to do likewise with the Words of God. they are life, healing and health. Faith in God is faith in His word.

Ever wondered why we take the Doctor's instructions so seriously yet take the Word of God with a pinch of salt? Let us reverence the Word of God as it so deserves. Let us reverence the integrity of the Word. No Word of God will be void of power. It is the Word that goes out of your mouth that cannot return to Him void. **Luke 1:37** *"For with God nothing is ever impossible and no word from God shall be without power or impossible of fulfilment."*


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
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
