SOARING AS AN EAGLE

PREAMBLE: The Eagle Way!

How beautiful are the feet of those who proclaim the good news and goodness of our God. (Romans 10:13-15)

Our God does beautiful things in all situations and would desire us to be elegant as the eagle in displaying the splendour and wonder of His love because we are reverently, fearfully and wonderfully made according to the scriptures in **Psalms** 48:1-2 and Ecclesiastes 3:11 and Psalms 139:14 and Isaiah 52:7.

But for the indwelling Holy Spirit in us, these wonders of God in our human nature are on display in the EAGLE. Wisdom can be learnt of it as we study its leadership and mentorship qualities.

Today, the Christian faith is continuing to be challenged even in evolving ways. Technology, medicine, science and the works of satanic and demonic modus operandi are challenging the authenticity of our faith in Christ Jesus the Lord. Knowing the times we live in, we ought to do a redress of who we are in order to live effectually and efficiently.

We live in such a time in which we need to register our faith solely on Him that has made us, through whom we have the breath of life - The Holy Spirit. Only by the Holy Spirit can we deal with the affairs of life in achieving our desired goals today.

Acts 17:24-29 "God that made the world and all things therein, seeing that he is Lord of heaven and earth, dwelleth not in temples made with hands; 25 neither is worshipped with men's hands, as though he needed any thing, seeing he giveth to all life, and breath, and all things; 26 and hath made of one blood all nations of men for to dwell on all the face of the earth, and hath determined the times before appointed, and the bounds of their habitation; 27 that they should seek the Lord, if haply they might feel after him, and find him, though he be not far from every one of us: 28 for in him we live, and move, and have our being; as certain also of your own poets have said, For we are also his offspring. 29 Forasmuch then as we are the offspring of God, we ought not to think that the Godhead is like unto gold, or silver, or stone, graven by art and man's device."

Genesis 2:7 "And the Lord God formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living soul."

Job 33:4 "The Spirit of God hath made me, and the breath of the Almighty hath given me life".

Job 32:8 "But there is a spirit in man: and the inspiration of the Almighty gives them understanding".

Acts 17:24-29 and Job 33:4 and Job 32:8 and *Genesis 2:7* give an insight and foresight of who we are, of what and how we are made, and to whom and from whom and through whom we live our life today. The sum of that is the Holy Spirit. We have our being and live through Him. We are made by the Spirit of God. He's our breath and not the oxygen that we know of in science. When the Holy Spirit breathed into us, we became a living being and we are sustained today and each day by that breath and inspiration of God which gives us the true understanding on how to do life on this side of heaven in relationship to our creator.

Foreknowing that we are God's offspring and the sheep of His pasture and that deep calls unto deep, it's imperative that we examine our ways from the perspectives of the life of - The Eagle!

Proverbs 30:18-19 "There be three things which are too wonderful for me, yea, four which I know not: The way of an eagle in the air; the way of a serpent upon a rock; the way of a ship in the midst of the sea; and the way of a man with a maid"

Proverbs 30:18-19 above speaks of three things, which the wise King Solomon earnestly declares are too wonderful for him to comprehend, one of which is - 'The Way of an Eagle in the Air'. Man for many years has taken eagles as a symbol of beauty, bravery, courage, honour, pride, determination and grace. And when you understand the ways of an eagle

the air in achieving your life set goals and desires, then triumphant, victor, winner and more than conqueror will become your new identity. I pray it becomes so in Jesus' name, Amen.

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Proverbs 13:15 "Good understanding gives favour: but the way of transgressors is hard (difficult)" (Emphasis Mine).

The understanding of the characteristics of eagle as it has been closely associated to leadership and mentorship will give us the enabling inspiration, revelation and empowerment to soaring as an eagle. Eagles are venerated as living symbols of power, freedom, and transcendence. This understanding breeds favour and the contrary makes leadership cum mentorship difficult and as such frustrates one out of life favours as *Proverbs* 13:15 above indicates.

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The Eagle Way: CHARACTERISTICS OF THE EAGLE

Proverbs 30:18-19 "There be three things which are too wonderful for me, yea, four which I know not: The way of an eagle in the air; the way of a serpent upon a rock; the way of a ship in the midst of the sea; and the way of a man with a maid"

The way of an Eagle in the air indicates the splendour, wonderful and elegant display with simplicity in the nature of the eagle. The Eagle tends to rejuvenate and revitalise itself in old age to keep itself full of life and vision. Eagles do not allow age to deter them, instead renew their days to keep themselves alive and in command as the king of the air.

It is a large bird of prey with a massive hooked bill and long broad wings, known and noted for its keenness of sight, which is vision, and size, strength and powerful soaring flight. Eagles are a symbol of beauty, bravery, courage, honour, pride, determination and grace. They are venerated as living symbols of power, freedom, and transcendence. What makes this bird so important and symbolic to humanity are its characteristics.

Some characteristics of the eagle:

VISION - known for their keenness of sight

FEARLESSNESS - Brave (ferocious)

TENACITY - Fierceness (aggressive)

VITALITY - Known to re-energise (metamorphosis)

ALTITUDE - Known as high flyers

MENTORING - Known for nurturing their young

NON - SCAVENGERS - Known not to eat dead meat

COMMUNITY - Known to flock together

TRUSTING - The Eagles are known to ensure assurance

ELEGANCE - Known for beauty

The Eagle Way: IT IS TO SOAR

Proverbs 30:18-19 "There be three things which are too wonderful for me, yea, four which I know not: The way of an eagle in the air; the way of a serpent upon a rock; the way of a ship in the midst of the sea; and the way of a man with a maid"

John 3:8 "The wind bloweth where it listeth, and thou hearest the sound thereof, but canst not tell whence it cometh, and whither it goeth: so is every one that is born of the Spirit."

To soar is:

- To rise or fly upwards into the sky
- To glide while maintaining altitude
- To rise or increase suddenly above the usual level or expectation

Soaring as an eagle in this context, is soaring in the faith by the Holy Spirit, in such a way that we can be able to attain the reality of our altitude of grace in Christ Jesus.

It's the way to be effectual and efficient in our Faith walk in actualising the reality of our redemption as detailed in *Philemon 6 and Ephesians 3:20-21.*

Philemon 6 "That the communication of thy faith may become effectual by the acknowledging of every

good thing which is in you in Christ Jesus."

Ephesians 3:20-21 "Now unto him that is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that worketh in us, 21 unto him be glory in the church by Christ Jesus throughout all ages, world without end. Amen."

Our God intends for all His children with an achievers mandate to soar if they must BECOME what they are born or made to be in Christ Jesus. Our God wants you to triumphantly maintain that altitude of grace as it affects every single area of your wellbeing and faith in Him. That is, to be completely whole in every area of our life according to 1 Thessalonians 5:23. You are redeemed to be a SOARER on the Holy Spirit in Christ Jesus our Lord.

1 Thessalonians 5:23

"And the very God of peace sanctify you wholly; and I pray God your whole spirit and soul and body be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ."

It's time to soar over your mountain, valley, crooked and rough places as an eagle. You cannot be meddling with chickens and pigeons and expect to gain eagle's heights. Neither can you live as an ostrich or a turkey and enjoy eagle ways. The eagles are known for beauty, strength, vision, mission and more.

There are even more characteristics of an eagle to enhance your path to the high places wherein God has positioned us in Christ Jesus according to **Ephesians 2:6-10:**

"And hath raised us up together, and made (positioned) us sit together in heavenly places in Christ Jesus: 7 that in the ages (World) to come he might shew the exceeding riches of his grace in his kindness toward us through Christ Jesus. 8 For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: 9 not of works, lest any man should boast. 10 For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them" (Emphasis mine)

The Eagle Way:

TO WAIT AND OBSERVE THE WIND

Isaiah 40:31"But they that wait upon the Lord shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint".

Eagles observes patiently in wait of the moving of the wind, then mount out its wings on it, then glide, that is, soar through the moving of the wind to heights of gracefulness. This is why it is referred to as the king of the Sky.

The eagle doesn't flap wings as do pigeons and turkeys; and because of this does not burn out of synergy as quickly as others. More so, you can't play with turkeys and wants to fly over your mountain, valley, crooked road and rough places as the eagles. Either you are both flapping and burning out strength, complaining and murmuring or you are mounting up wings on the wind and no burning out and riding above your mountains.

The Holy Spirit is symbolized as the wind. When the Holy Spirit moves in the Bible days as in *Genesis 1:1-2* to indicate about how creation came to be; God spoke through the moving wind (Holy Spirit), that is, glides through it, creation then came to be.

The earth that was null and void became the fullness of gracious things as we marvel today of God's creation. When you glide on the wings of the wind, the precious Holy Spirit, you can't be burnt out, or go weary or faint; but if you don't glide on the wind, you will keep flapping, be burnt out and never be the king of the sky as the eagle in fulfilling your purposes.

Hence it's not enough to have the Holy Spirit indwelling in you, you must consciously be led, that is, glide (soar), through Him to attain the fullness.

Galatians 5:18, 25 "But if ye be led of the Spirit, ye are not under the law . . . If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit."

Job 32:8 "But there is a spirit in man: and the inspiration of the Almighty giveth them understanding."

Job 33:4 "The Spirit of God hath made me, and the breath of the Almighty hath given me life."

Get engaged today, through observation and waiting, on the moving of the wind, which is the breath of life, the Holy Spirit Himself, in all you do, rather than flapping in human wisdom and philosophy. That's what Galatians 5:18, 25 and Job 32:8 and Job 33:4 speak of; that your life is sustained by the breath of God and you need to take time to wait on this breath to lead and direct you rather than jump ahead and be sluggish all the time. We must always remember that the spirit of man is the candle, sensor and lamp of the Lord; hence we can't but be led of the Holy Spirit.

Proverbs 20:27 "The spirit of man is the candle of the Lord, searching all the inward parts of the belly".

The Eagle Way:

RENEWAL OF STRENGTH!

Psalms 103:1-5 "Bless the Lord, O my soul: and all that is within me, bless his holy name . . . 5 who satisfieth thy mouth with good things; so that thy youth is renewed like the eagle's."

Isaiah 40:31 "But they that wait upon the Lord shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint"

Psalms 92:10-15 "But my horn shalt thou exalt like the horn of an unicorn: I shall be anointed with fresh oil. 11 Mine eye also shall see my desire on mine enemies, and mine ears shall hear my desire of the wicked that rise up against me. 12 The righteous shall flourish like the palm tree: he shall grow like a cedar in Lebanon. 13 Those that be planted in the house of the Lord shall flourish in the courts of our God. 14 They shall still bring forth fruit in old age; they shall be fat and flourishing; 15 to shew that the Lord is upright: he is my rock, and there is no unrighteousness in him."

Don't get burnt out before you evaluate your life in every dimension. That's what *Psalms 103:1-5 and*

Isaiah 40:31 admonish us to take note of. Eagles are living examples on how we need to live and do life. Age is no limitation to the eagle. **Psalms 92:10-15** enjoins us to be fruitful and flourish in old age; simply for the fact that the eagle does not flap and hence doesn't get burnt out easily on its synergy. While gliding on the wind, their wings are at rest. When we do life with the Holy Spirit, our wind, we won't be burnt out except we choose otherwise. Those who wait upon the Lord renew strength, when they have to run will not be weary and when they walk, they will not faint. God's WORD can't fail when we respect the process as ascribed to us.

However, when the eagle is expected to deteriorate, retire and be weakened by virtue of age from being the king of the sky, it sheds off its old and weak feathers, reenergises for the new and refreshes by taking some time out to evaluate, thus enabling much more years to rule in the sky. This is the eagle way!

Mark 6: 30-32 "And the apostles gathered themselves together unto Jesus, and told him all things, both what they had done, and what they had taught. 31 And he said unto them, Come ye yourselves apart into a desert place, and rest a while: for there were many coming and going, and they had no leisure so much as to eat. 32 And they departed into a desert place by ship privately."

Isaiah 28:11-12 "For with stammering lips and another tongue will he speak to this people. 12 To whom he said, This is the rest wherewith ye may cause the weary to rest; and this is the refreshing: yet they would not hear."

Isaiah 28:11-12 and Mark 6:30-32 tell us of the need to rest, to be refreshed, eat and have some leisure. While Isaiah speaks of the refreshing power of the Holy Spirit, in Mark the scriptures enjoin us of the need to take time off to rest to have leisure of refreshing as well. When is the last time you did an evaluation on your life, that is, do some check and balance with the Holy Spirit on the assignment you've committed into His hands and that had been given to you to accomplish. (By assignment I mean your marriage, family, career, ministry, education, relationship, business, politics and more). Jesus and His disciples had time to rest, refresh, take leisure and to evaluate, that is, to do check and balance on the assignment at hand instead of unending work, work, work.

2 Corinthians 4:16 "For which cause we faint not; but though our outward man perish, yet the inward man is renewed day by day."

Psalms 84:7 "They go from strength to strength, every one of them in Zion appeareth before God."

There is no reason for fainting, but to go from strength to strength to all who appear in God's presence is the promise in God's living Word for all - 2 Corinthians 4:16; Psalms 84:7. It's time you take a holiday to evaluate, refresh, renew, revitalize and rejuvenate your relationships with all you do in life as your assignment from God to humanity. You need to take time to be with the Holy Spirit outside work as Psalms 16:11 and Luke 9:28-29 exemplify to us.

Psalms 16:11 "Thou wilt shew me the path of life: in thy presence is fulness of joy; at thy right hand there are pleasures for evermore."

Luke 9:28-29 "And it came to pass about an eight days after these sayings, he took Peter and John and James, and went up into a mountain to pray. 29 And as he prayed, the fashion of his countenance was altered, and his raiment was white and glistering." (Luke 9:28-35)

I pray today, that the prayer in lamentations will cause you to ask of God to help you renew your day as of old by having time spent to rest with the wind, the blessed Holy Spirit. This will put an end to complaints, sorrow and murmuring in our walk with God. Stop now and take out time to rest with the Holy Spirit of rest.

Lamentations 5:21 "Turn thou us unto thee, O Lord, and we shall be turned; renew our days as of old"

The Eagle Way:

KNOWN & DETERMINED BY THE WIND, THE HOLY SPIRIT

Proverbs 30:18-19 "There be three things which are too wonderful for me, yea, four which I know not: The way of an eagle in the air; the way of a serpent upon a rock; the way of a ship in the midst of the sea; and the way of a man with a maid"

The Eagle is known for its majestic power, strength, beauty and dominion in the sky. It's capable of displaying this majestic glory and wonders of its fathered wings on the sky in that it's soaring on the power of the WIND – Proverbs 30:18-19; the mounting up of its wings, strength is preserved to display and sustain it's glorious, wonders, beauty and might longer and longer in the sky.

The Eagle sees nothing but the Wind to indicate its presence in the sky and to accomplish any mission at any point. No wind, no soaring! The eagle needs the wind to glide or soar in order to show and demonstrate that it is the king of the sky. The way of the eagle in the air is only known and determined by the wind. The eagle knows and understands the movement of the wind to do whatsoever.

John 3:6-8 "That which is born of the flesh is flesh; and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit. 7 Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again. 8 The wind bloweth where it listeth, and

thou hearest the sound thereof, but canst not tell whence it cometh, and whither it goeth: so is every one that is born of the Spirit."

The Wind is the Holy Spirit in the life of a Believer as **John 3:6-8** above indicates. No wind, no divine accomplishment for the believers; No matter how religiously we do things it's all dogmas and fulfilling men wishes and traditions and not divinely inspired, revealed and empowered.

The heavens only recognise one wind, the blessed Holy Spirit. When you glide through your marriage, family, relationship, career, business, ministry and more on the power of the WIND, the HOLY SPIRIT, you can then be able to weather any storm, such that the unease becomes ease, the mountains becomes plains, the valleys are filled or exalted, the crooked roads and rough places becomes straight and smooth respectively.

Give the Holy Spirit the chance to help you soar through life again; you will glide in majesty, power and strength as the eagle does. For with God, it's not by human power or acquisition, might, eloquence or such things, but by the Holy Spirit; **Zachariah 4:5-7**. In life there are mountains, valleys, crooked roads, rough places and more, but by gliding or soaring on the Holy Spirit, we can get to our high places with ease and grace as **Isaiah 40:3-5 and 31** indicates.

Zechariah 4:5-7 "Then the angel that talked with me answered and said unto me, Knowest thou not what these be? And I said, No, my lord. 6 Then he answered and spake unto me, saying, This is the word of the Lord unto Zerubbabel, saying, Not by might, nor by power, but by my spirit, saith the Lord of hosts. 7 Who art thou, O great mountain? before Zerubbabel thou shalt become a plain: and he shall bring forth the headstone thereof with shoutings, crying, Grace, grace unto it."

Isaiah 40:3-5, 31 "The voice of him that crieth in the wilderness, Prepare ye the way of the Lord, make straight in the desert a highway for our God. 4 Every valley shall be exalted, and every mountain and hill shall be made low: and the crooked shall be made straight, and the rough places plain: 5 and the glory of the Lord shall be revealed, and all flesh shall see it together: for the mouth of the Lord hath spoken it... but they that wait upon the Lord shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint."

Soaring as an eagle is only possible if you can recognise the movement of the wind - The Holy Spirit. This will emancipate and deliver one from all yokes and burdens affecting our drive to actualise our life potentials and desired goals.

Unlike most birds, the eagle does not flap its wings but mount them up for flight in relation to the movement of the wind. It's by this swift or prompt agility to get on the wind that takes the eagle to greater heights and places without exhaustion.

The scripture likens the wind to the Holy Spirit as a metaphor shown in **John 3:8.** And our ability to know and understand the move of the Holy Spirit in relation to our life goals makes all the difference in the kingdom.

Genesis 1:1-4 "In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth. And the earth was without form, and void; and darkness was upon the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters. And God said, Let there be light: and there was light. And God saw the light, that it was good: and God divided the light from the darkness".

When the Holy Spirit moves and hovers over the face of the waters on earth, God knowing the indication of that movement, begins to speak forth, makes prophetic creative declarations. And that's how creation was made upon the earth. In the same manner, when an achiever comes to know and understand the move of the Holy Spirit, creativity and the pursuit to achieve life goals will begin to take it direction.

John 7:37-39 "In the last day, that great day of the feast, Jesus stood and cried, saying, If any man thirst, let him come unto me, and drink. 38 He that believeth on me, as the scripture hath said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water. 39 (But this spake he of the Spirit, which they that believe on him should receive: for the Holy Ghost was not yet given;

because that Jesus was not yet glorified.)

Luke 24:49 "And, behold, I send the promise of my Father upon you: but tarry ye in the city of Jerusalem, until ye be endued with power from on high."

Acts 1:8 "But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judæa, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth."

Beloved, John 7:37-39, Luke 24:49 and Acts 1:8 tell us of God's intent to give to all who believe and thirst for the Holy Spirit. God desires to empower us so that we can be able to do life with ease, being led and not with complaints and murmuring. It's only possible by gliding or soaring on the wind - the Holy Spirit of promise to all who believe in Him - *John 14:16-17*. He dwells in you, is with you and directs every necessary affair of yours so that you will be able to live free from all form of stress and stay in rest. How I do pray that this inspiration and revelation and empowerment will find its place in your spirit today, in Jesus' precious name, amen!

John 14:16-17 "And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another Comforter, that he may abide with you for ever; 17 even the Spirit of truth; whom the world cannot receive, because it seeth him not, neither knoweth him: but ye know him; for he dwelleth with you, and shall be in you."

Isaiah 28:11-12 "For with stammering lips and another tongue will he speak to this people. 12 To whom he said, This is the rest wherewith ye may cause the weary to rest; and this is the refreshing: yet they would not hear."

The Eagle Way:

IT IS BY VISION

Proverbs 29:18 "Where there is no vision, the people perish: but he that keepeth the law, happy is he"

Habakkuk 2:1-3 "I will stand upon my watch, and set me upon the tower, and will watch to see what he will say unto me, and what I shall answer when I am reproved. 2 And the Lord answered me, and said, Write the vision, and make it plain upon tables, that he may run that readeth it. 3 For the vision is yet for an appointed time, but at the end it shall speak, and not lie: though it tarry, wait for it; because it will surely come, it will not tarry."

Proverbs 29:18 and Habakkuk 2:1-3 make it clear and simple that no mission can ever be comprehensive and achievable when there's no vision to it. A leadership mission is only as authentic as the vision! It's disastrous to lead without vision and to follow anybody with no vision, otherwise you will both perish. There's no room for speculations where human lives, money, time and materials are involved.

A clear cutting-edge vision will always sustain a mission no matter how long it takes and the opposition and challenges that will be involved. Write the vision down, make it plain, not complicated, so that those who buy into it will keep and sustain its continuity otherwise it's dead even before the mission starts.

Isaiah 6:1-9 "In the year that king Uzziah died I saw (vision) also the Lord sitting upon a throne, high and lifted up, and his train filled the temple. 2 Above it stood the seraphims: each one had six wings; with twain he covered his face, and with twain he covered his feet, and with twain he did fly. 3 And one cried unto another, and said, Holy, holy, holy, is the Lord of hosts: the whole earth is full of his glory. 4 And the posts of the door moved at the voice of him that cried, and the house was filled with smoke. 5 Then said I, Woe is me! for I am undone; because I am a man of unclean lips, and I dwell in the midst of a people of unclean lips: for mine eyes have seen the King, the Lord of hosts. 6 Then flew one of the seraphims unto me, having a live coal in his hand, which he had taken with the tongs from off the altar: 7 and he laid it upon my mouth, and said, Lo, this hath touched thy lips; and thine iniquity is taken away, and thy sin purged. 8 Also I heard the voice of the Lord, saying, Whom shall I send, and who will go for us? Then said I, Here am I; send me. 9 And he

said, Go, and tell this people, Hear ye indeed, but understand not; and see ye indeed, but perceive not." (Emphasis mine)

The Eagle is known to be visionary, because of its sharp sightedness. When Isaiah in Isaiah 6:1-9 had the clarity; when he was full of knowledge and understood the details of the mission as was expected of him in the vision that he saw, he could no longer be stopped. Foresight and insight are the great attributes that characterized this awesome creation of God. Isaiah had an upward vision of God and inward vision of himself. With the outward vision of what needs to be done; the sky was no longer the limit. He went forward and accomplished his God given mission in life.

When you know and understand your product and the raw materials to accomplish it as well as the market for it and your intuition to that product, that product will never be out of the markets. That is what the visionary nature of the eagle is all about. Hence it can take on its prey that is on the ground from its gliding in the sky with a calculated move in such a grand style.

Romans 8:9-11" But ye are not in the flesh, but in the Spirit, if so be that the Spirit of God dwell in you. Now if any man have not the Spirit of Christ, he is none of his. 10 And if Christ be in you, the body is dead because of sin; but the Spirit is life because of righteousness. 11 But if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in

you, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwelleth in you."

1 Corinthians 2:9-16 "But as it is written. Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which God hath prepared for them that love him. 10 But God hath revealed them unto us by his Spirit: for the Spirit searcheth all things, yea, the deep things of God. 11 For what man knoweth the things of a man, save the spirit of man which is in him? even so the things of God knoweth no man, but the Spirit of God. 12 Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the spirit which is of God; that we might know the things that are freely given to us of God. 13 Which things also we speak, not in the words which man's wisdom teacheth, but which the Holy Ghost teacheth; comparing spiritual things with spiritual. 14 But the natural man receiveth not the things of the Spirit of God: for they are foolishness unto him: neither can he know them. because they are spiritually discerned. 15 But he that is spiritual judgeth all things, yet he himself is judged of no man. 16 For who hath known the mind of the Lord, that he may instruct him? But we have the mind of Christ."

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Romans 8:9-11 and 1 Corinthians 2:9-16 sum up the efficacy of the Holy Spirit's works in a believer's life. The indwelling Spirit gives the vision and helps to accomplish it accordingly. When we catch a vision which is of the Holy Spirit's revelation, there will be inspiration and empowerment accordingly to bring it to fruition.

That is why Apostle Paul in *Galatians 1:10-12* could say that the ministry committed into His hands came by revelation (vision) and not by the dogmas or traditions of men caught up on the road side as we've seen in recent times with many falsehoods in the name of God. No wonder Apostle Paul could accomplish beyond himself; because it's the Holy Spirit's vision packed made up his ministerial work and not man-made curriculum vitae, destiny definer, as we see today to justify who may or may not be.

Galatians 1:10-12 "For do I now persuade men, or God? or do I seek to please men? for if I yet pleased men, I should not be the servant of Christ. 11 But I certify you, brethren, that the gospel which was preached of me is not after man. 12 For I neither received it of man, neither was I taught it, but by the revelation of Jesus Christ." (Galatians 1:1-24)

Where there's leadership without vision, missions collapse, resulting in the waste of finances, material, time and people. Where there's no vision, the mission of the family, business, career, ministry, government, governance and more collapses. In fact, anointing will become an annoyance due to the frustration of the mission. By the indwelling Holy Spirit in you for insight and foresight, you can colour your worlds and ensure the atmosphere you want to enjoy and visualize come to reality.

The Eagle Way:

LEADERSHIP AND MENTORING - THE EAGLE & THE EAGLET!

Deuteronomy 32:7-14 "Remember the days of old, consider the years of many generations: ask thy father, and he will shew thee; thy elders, and they will tell thee. 8 When the most High divided to the nations their inheritance, when he separated the sons of Adam, he set the bounds of the people according to the number of the children of Israel. 9 For the Lord's portion is his people; Jacob is the lot of his inheritance. He found him in a desert land, and in the waste howling wilderness; he led him about, he instructed him, he kept him as the apple of his eye. 11 As an eagle stirreth up her nest, fluttereth over her young, spreadeth abroad her wings, taketh them, beareth them on her wings: 12 so the Lord alone did lead him, and there was no strange god with him. 13 He made him ride on the high places of the earth, that he might eat the increase of the fields; and he made him to suck honey out of the rock,

and oil out of the flinty rock; 14 butter of kine, and milk of sheep, with fat of lambs, and rams of the breed of Bashan, and goats, with the fat of kidneys of wheat; and thou didst drink the pure blood of the grape"

Isaiah 9:6-7 "For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given: and the government shall be upon his shoulder: and his name shall be called Wonderful, Counsellor, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace. 7 Of the increase of his government and peace there shall be no end, upon the throne of David, and upon his kingdom, to order it, and to establish it with judgment and with justice from henceforth even for ever. The zeal of the Lord of hosts will perform this."

The eagle is a large keen-sighted bird of prey with a massive hooked bill and long, large broad wings and a strong soaring flight. The eaglet, otherwise, is the young eagle. The wise and true faithful saying in life is that "Eagles are made, while eaglets are born".

In the same scenario as the eagle and eaglet, a child is born, but a son is made. Sonship is not a given neither should a child be born for nothing. The eagle's way in this context is simply about the eagle and the eaglet, that is, leadership and mentoring. For success without a successor is failure in disguise, just as prosperity without posterity in view is a complete disaster indeed. The eagle without the eaglet

closes down a generation or community just as the sheep without the lamb closes continuity. Yet many have despised this concept in life and have left generations in darkness and peril. We see it in government, families, businesses, corporations and such like.

Deuteronomy 32:7-14 helps to buttress how the eagle will take the eaglet on a flying expedition, to teach it to know and understand the wind, mount up its' wings at the movement and direction of the wind rather than flapping and burning it's strength. The eaglets are taught not only how to glide, but also the prize to comfort, feeding and making shelter and doing life in order to live through their life span. The various characteristics of the eagle as written earlier are brought to the knowledge of the eaglet. In its growth, the eaglet is exposed to situations that would strengthen the characteristics of the eagle in it that were mentioned earlier. They fully participate in the work and in turn learn the reward.

The eagle unlike the ostrich is known for replicating its kind called the eaglet by the amount parental personal responsibility through diligence and devotion that is



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to make it happen; while unlike the Eagle, the Ostrich pay not or attached any personal parental care through diligent and devotion in raising it's kind.

The eagle's leadership acumen is turning another eaglet into an eagle. Meaning, eagles are diligent in making the eaglet to become another king of the sky. This is where leadership and mentoring is very important in any phase of human history or life. Jesus said like father like son, in the same, like mother like daughter.

Proverbs 30:18-19 "There be three things which are too wonderful for me, yea, four which I know not: The way of an eagle in the air; the way of a serpent upon a rock; the way of a ship in the midst of the sea; and the way of a man with a maid"

The sky is so broad that there can be no clashes and jealousy for any that wills diligently to become and to make others to be in the sky. That's the act that makes the eagle to turn the eaglet to be king of the sky. This phenomenon is the same, whether in family, ministry, business, career, or politics and in every endeavour of human acts of doing life; you can become and make others become if you will. Eagles are characterised when it comes to - Leadership and mentorship. The leadership and mentoring knowing and understanding of the Eagle and Eaglet way, in terms also of the being a son and a child - makes the great difference in one's life.

Proverbs 27:23 "Be thou diligent to know the state of thy flocks, and look well to thy herds."

Proverbs 22:29 "Seest thou a man diligent in his business? he shall stand before kings; he shall not stand before mean men."

Hebrews 11:6 "But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him."

The eagle's diligent act in leadership and mentorship are second to none because of their intent and the rewards for continuity as **Proverbs 27:23**, **Proverbs 22:29 and Hebrews 11:6** enjoins. In the same scenario, Jesus said to Peter in **John 21:15-17**, feed (look after) my sheep and my lambs. When the sheep are well looked after they give life to the lambs; and when the lambs are well looked after, they become sheep to give life to another lamb, the process of reproducing ones kind becomes inevitable. Make converts into disciples and let disciples make converts, that is, replicate. That's what leadership and mentoring entails for anybody who intends to have their plans, purpose and pursuits live beyond or after them with same or better tenacity and graciousness.

John 21:15-17 "So when they had dined, Jesus saith to Simon Peter, Simon, son of Jonas, lovest thou me more than these? He saith unto him, Yea, Lord; thou knowest that I love thee. He saith unto him, Feed my lambs. 16 He saith to him again the second time, Simon, son of Jonas, lovest thou me? He saith unto him, Yea, Lord; thou knowest that

I love thee. He saith unto him, Feed my sheep. 17 He saith unto him the third time, Simon, son of Jonas, lovest thou me? Peter was grieved because he said unto him the third time, Lovest thou me? And he said unto him, Lord, thou knowest all things; thou knowest that I love thee. Jesus saith unto him, Feed my sheep."

Proverbs 27:23 "Be thou diligent to know the state of thy flocks, and look well to thy herds."

Leadership without appropriate mentorship destroys the seed of greatness; and mentorship without appropriate leadership is dangerous to humanity and to ones plans, purposes and pursuits. That's the driving force in Apostle Paul's intent to the Roman and Corinthian Christians on one of his visits as found in the following scriptures:

Romans 1:11-12 "For I long to see you, that I may impart unto you some spiritual gift, to the end ye may be established; 12 that is, that I may be comforted together with you by the mutual faith both of you and me."

2 Corinthians 11:28

"Beside those things that are without, that which cometh upon me daily, the care of all the churches".

Stop being a Boss! Be a leader and start mentoring. Stop wandering around, locate a leader and submit to mentorship. Greatness is within your

reach, cleave to the wind, the Holy Spirit, He will glide you to greatness if you are willing and obedient. Don't wander away from knowledge and understanding; don't stop mentoring for posterity. And with a willing and obedient heart of care and passion, both will eat the good of the land as we see in the following scriptures.

Proverbs 21:16 "The man that wandereth out of the way of understanding shall remain in the congregation of the dead."

Proverbs 13:15 "Good understanding giveth favour: but the way of transgressors is hard."

Isaiah 1:19 "If ye be willing and obedient, ye shall eat the good of the land:"

When you know and understand the biblical concept of becoming an eagle and also an eaglet as I have laid out in this context and edition, you will soar and by it will end all those anxieties and worries that makes you think there is no hope for tomorrow. Unless you decide to still remain an eaglet who wants to enjoy the eagle lifestyle and don't want to undergo God's make-over that transforms an eaglet to an eagle as in the following examples:

JESUS CHRIST OUR EXAMPLE:

Isaiah 9:6 "For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given . . ."

John 3:16 "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only

begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life"

The above prophetic scripture about our Lord Jesus Christ indicates the transformation and positioning of an eaglet to an eagle. As a child Jesus was born, but as a Son was given (made). When made, one is empowered to achieve, rule and reign in life. God could only give Jesus to save the world as a Son, not as a child. It took thirty years for Jesus to undergo an eaglet life make-over and translation for a three and half year eagle mandate. Hence He succeeded. And the scripture (*Joshua 1:8*) enjoins us to learn of Him if we must have good success and prosper as our Lord promises us and did - The eagle way!

THE REDEEMED IN CHRIST

Galatians 4:1-7 "Now I say, That the heir, as long as he is a child, differed nothing from a servant, though he be lord of all; But is under tutors and governors until the time appointed of the father. Even so we, when we were children, were in bondage under the elements of the world: But when the fullness of the time was come, God sent forth his Son, made of a woman, made under the law, To redeem them that were under the law, that we might receive the adoption of sons. And because ye are sons, God hath sent forth the Spirit of his Son into your hearts, crying, Abba, Father. Wherefore thou art no more a servant, but a son; and if a son, then an heir of God through Christ".

From the epistle of Galatians above, it's clear how God wants His children as Abraham's seed and achievers to possess an eagle mandate than that of an eaglet. As a child (eaglet) - one is under tutorship or training, while as a Son (eagle) - one is made to bear rule, reign and take charge and control. (1 Peter 2:2; Isaiah 28:9-12; Hebrews 5:11-14).

The danger of many Christian families, marriages, relationships, businesses, careers and ministries is that la lot of people want to enjoy the eagle lifestyle with eaglet mentality and behaviour to life issues. This has hindered the true joy reality of their Christian faith. The world and creation awaits the manifestation and revealing of God's sons and not mere children, by taking their place for the beauty of mankind. Will you arise and take your place as a son!

Romans 8:19 "For the earnest expectation of the creature waiteth for the manifestation (revealing) of the sons of God".

1 Corinthians 13:11 "When I was a child, I spoke as a child, I understood as a child, I thought as a child: but when I became a man (son), I put away childish things" (Emphasis mine)

The Eagle Way:

TO DRESS UP FOR THE THRONE YOU'VE ENVISIONED AND DREAMT ABOUT!

Joel 2:28-29 "And it shall come to pass afterward, that I will pour out my spirit upon all flesh; and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your old men shall dream dreams, your young men shall see visions: 29 and also upon the servants and upon the handmaids in those days will I pour out my spirit."

What fascinated me in taking on this subject is Joseph as we see him in Genesis 37 and Genesis 41 and **Psalms 105**. He caught my imagination as one with the eagle eye though he was an ordinary man. His being able to catch a vision separated him from his mates and equals and defined him for a destiny yet to unfold ahead of him which eventually came to pass. The visionary eagle concept is to attain and get to anything that catches its attention. Hence the eagle is being described as a tenacious creature, because it will keep and sustain that vision until the prey is caught unaware of this gracious advance of a visionary and tenacious creature no matter what it takes and how long it takes. That is the essence of Joel 2:28-29, speaking about visions, dreams and prophesying, that is declaring it or following it through until it becomes a reality.

Genesis 37:1-8 "...5 And Joseph dreamed a dream,

and he told it his brethren: and they hated him yet the more. 6 And he said unto them, Hear, I pray you, this dream which I have dreamed: 7 for, behold, we were binding sheaves in the field, and, lo, my sheaf arose, and also stood upright; and, behold, your sheaves stood round about, and made obeisance to my sheaf. 8 And his brethren said to him, Shalt thou indeed reign over us? or shalt thou indeed have dominion over us? And they hated him yet the more for his dreams, and for his words."

In *Genesis 37:1-8*, Joseph being one of the twelve sons of Jacob who was later called Israel had a visionary dream to become a Prime Minister. All he had was a visionary dream without knowing how it would work out but assured that it was of God. He shared it with family members. Apostle Paul of Galatians chapter one addressed this on how to keep revelations outside men who may likely be used to kill it or even kill you. Through the years that visionary dream kept him going by the wind towards his high place of graciousness. With all the turbulent time of giving up in life, defamed before his father and sold for thirty pieces of silver by his own, serving as a houseboy in Potiphar's cottage, wrongly accused and sentenced to prison. All this would have been enough to have killed him or his visionary dream. Instead, it was the visionary dream that was sustaining him in all its journey and

passing phases of doing life. He never allowed his circumstances to imprison him but overwhelmed his circumstances by his visionary dream. That's the spirit of a soaring eagle. Joseph has it.

Genesis 41:14, 37-45 "Then Pharaoh sent and called Joseph, and they brought him hastily out of the dungeon: and he shaved himself, and changed his raiment, and came in unto Pharaoh..."

Genesis 41 was the turning point of this man Joseph who was in prison in spite of been forgotten by those he helped and as it were, waiting to die with his visionary dream, he had a call. A call from the Pharaoh, the king of the land of Egypt where he was a stranger, a foreigner and name it, he was it. This call was to decide his destiny at that time, either to be sentenced to death or to be acquitted and freed. This is my best bit of all, Genesis 41:14 indicates that as an eagle with a visionary dream, instead of dressing up to see the king as prisoner with a prison look and attire, he shaved; he cleaned himself up; he put on his best clothes that matched up to his visionary dream; He refused to be imprisoned but freed himself from within and set up a goal that he would not return as a prisoner but he by his visionary dream would be the answer to the quest of the day. He lived and dressed up daily with his visionary dream as an eagle with a tenacious spirit that as he soared and glided through the wind, he will surely get to his high place of life.

Psalms 105:17-22 "He sent a man before them, even Joseph, who was sold for a servant: 18 whose feet they hurt with fetters: he was laid in iron: 19 until the time that his word came: the word of the Lord tried him. 20 The king sent and loosed him; even the ruler of the people, and let him go free. 21 He made him lord of his house, and ruler of all his substance: 22 to bind his princes at his pleasure; and teach his senators wisdom."

The rest is history today as **Psalms 105:17-22** affirms that he became the Prime Minister of a country where he had been a stranger and a foreigner, simply because he believed and held unto his visionary dream as an eagle would through all passing phases of his life.

Only if you can believe again *Joel 2:28-29* as touching your life by entrusting all things in the hands of the wind, the blessed Holy Spirit, to take you along until the fulness of time. For its written in *Philippians 1:6*, that He that began a good work in you is able and abundantly able to bring it to fulfilment and fruitfulness. *Do you believe that?*

I therefore challenge you today to make a new relationship and fellowship with the Holy Spirit that you might soar (glide) in life. You can then chart your life of creativity for the world you long and want to have and enjoy.

The Eagle Way:

A GREAT DELIGHT

The eagle way is the believer's path way to achieving their God given life goals. When you understand the know-how of mounting up with wings as the eagle, you can keep yourself afloat over all mountains and valleys of life. The reasons behind all this is because human ideals and philosophy will fail us as we've seen over the years and more recently in our world economic turbulence in spite of all our gigantic empire of great intellectuals, economics, scientist and technologists, politicians and financiers and many, many more. Let's ponder and consider the scriptures below, in the light of the eagle way:

Deuteronomy 32:7-14

"Remember the days of old, consider the years of many *generations: ask thy father,* and he will show thee; thy elders, and they will tell thee ... As an eagle stirred up her nest, fluttered over her young, speeded abroad her wings, takes them, beareth them on her wings: So the LORD alone did lead him. and there was no strange god with him. He made him ride on the high places of the earth, that he might eat the increase of the fields; and he made him to suck honey out of the rock, and oil out of the flinty rock; Butter of kine, and milk of sheep, with fat of lambs, and rams of the breed of Bashan, and goats, with the fat of kidneys of wheat; and thou didst drink the pure blood of the grape".

The preceding scripture encompasses the very intent of God for His people. From nothing to splendid, that's the way the first church in the wilderness was raised - to soar as an eagle - and to raise the eaglet to become an eagle. As eagles they prospered, achieved their desired goals and God was in their midst.

Isaiah 40:31 "But they that wait upon the LORD shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint"

Isaiah 40:31 enjoins us to the eagle ways in these dimensions

The Eagle waits upon the wind - Holy Spirit - before it makes any move, hence it renews - does not waste/burn out - strength.

Psalm 103:5 "who satisfieth thy mouth with good things; so that thy youth is renewed like the eagle's."

The Eagle does not flap its wings - like other birds - but mounts up with wings and glide, hence: It does not go weary and does not go fainting (give up or loose heart)

Job 39:27 "Doth the eagle mount up at thy command, and make her nest on high?"

An achiever can't act as a turkey or other birds that flap wings and want to enjoy the height of an eagle that mounts up with wings.

Job 9:25-26 "Now my days are swifter than a post . . . They are passed away as the swift ships: as the eagle that hasteth to the prey".

The above scripture also indicates that eagles are not sluggish in life affairs. They are smart, quick, prompt and maximise opportunity. They don't take their timing to soar for granted. They act promptly at the movement of the wind.

There is more in store for you, it's the same for every child of God than can be imagined and this is made possible by the Holy Spirit. When we mount up our spiritual wings for flight as the eagles on the move of the wind - Holy Spirit, we can soar as the eagle to heights of greatness and the sky they say, will not just be our limit.


